Neighborhood Pavement Preservation Projects

Roadways in the Piney Glen Farm subdivision, Palatine subdivision and Brookfield subdivision will be prepared for resurfacing (patch and crack sealing) beginning May 6. The first phase will take approximately four weeks. Resurfacing will take place in summer/fall 2013. All work will be scheduled between the hours of 7am and 5pm.

Resurfacing preparation work (patch and crack sealing) is also scheduled for Mateny Road from Great Seneca Highway and Creamery Hill Drive in Germantown beginning May 13. This first phase of the project will take approximately 4 weeks with resurfacing scheduled to take place in summer/fall 2013. All work is scheduled between 9am-3pm.
