Recreation – indoor and outdoor aquatic facilities will be open (Germantown Indoor Swim Center will close at 3 p.m., all others will close at 6 pm.) and aquatic classes will meet as scheduled. All other classes and programs, including summer camps and fun centers, are cancelled. Administrative offices, senior centers and community centers are closed.

More about the CIP . . .

Residents, businesses, and community organizations are encouraged to provide input on the upcoming Capital Improvements Program (or CIP) for fiscal years 2014-2019. The CIP is done every two years and consists of a six-year program for making capital improvements in the county such as the construction and renovation of roads, schools, bridges, recreation centers, parks, police stations, fire stations, storm drains, sewer mains, and other infrastructure. The CIP also includes major programs such as housing preservation initiatives, and the public arts trust, as well as high school health and wellness centers.
