## Wheaton Urban District

• As the opening of the County office building and Town Plaza approach, urban district (WUD) staff are beginning to market the Town Plaza and plan for summer events, including coordinating with several government agencies regarding traffic, safety, parking and related issues. WUD has also been providing information to employees of agencies whose offices will be moving to the new building.

• WUD/RSC is scheduled to move to the new building first week of July. In addition to a request for a funds to accommodate the increased demands of the Town Plaza (and Veterans Park) for FY21 Operating Budget, a request has been submitted for funding this fiscal year specifically to be used prior to June 30<sup>th</sup> to build momentum in partnership with local businesses and residents, and to create protocols, policies necessary for the operation of this new facility.

- Taste of Wheaton June 7; Town Plaza debut late June.
- Through February, there will be traffic interruptions in downtown Wheaton as Reedie, Grandview, Veirs Mill and University Blvd are impacted by utility work related to both the Wheaton Revitalization and the Wheaton Gateway projects.

## Administrative & Community Activities

- The County's newest Senior Center at Wheaton Recreation Center began offering a variety of programs, with over 85 seniors participating in the first day of the lunch program.
- Two signature arts venues in Mid-County, the Sandy Spring Museum and Olney Theater, have launched initiatives to broaden their programming and audiences to traditionally under-represented parts of our community. Sandy Spring Museum has hired a folklife specialist and is putting together a task force of artists who represent the diverse cultures and art forms in our County; and Olney Theater held a free all-day event with panels, performances, workshops centered on the question of what home means.
