


## Rustic roads are historic and scenic roadways that reflect the agricultural character and rural origins of the county.

Rustic Roads Functional Master Plan Update

- 99 roads are currently designated as rustic or exceptional rustic roads
- County code preserves these roads, including certain designated Significant Features of each road.
- The Rustic Roads Advisory Committee oversees the program and advises the County Executive, County Council and Planning Board


