General Discussion:

The ABS members toured the new ABS retail store with Kent Massie. The tour began around 9:00 AM and ended at about 9:30 AM. Ms. Heltemes asked where shoplifting falls on list the of priorities. Lt. Currie said it depends on the circumstance. How much of a response? Is someone detained? Ms. Heltemes asked if ABS calls a non-emergency number or 911 to report incidents. Mr. Massie explained the police is always called because employees usually aren't aware of the circumstances. He also explained that ABS retail stores expect to hire a loss prevention manager who will target high theft stores as well as internal theft.

Mr. Gaughn asked if compliance checks have resumed, and Lt. Currie confirmed that they have and that the majority of the places in Silver Spring are not licensed. He said that from a police department standpoint they want them to continue. And added that the department currently has vacancies in Alcohol Division. Ms. Durbin explained that ABS is mandated to do 400 compliance checks per year. Ms. Virador commented the importance of businesses not overserving customers. Ms. Heltemes asked if the board could write a letter to support moving Human Resources. Ms. Durbin said they could if they would like but its supported. She added that most of the issues ABS is experiencing is related to Covid. Parents not allowing kids to participate.
