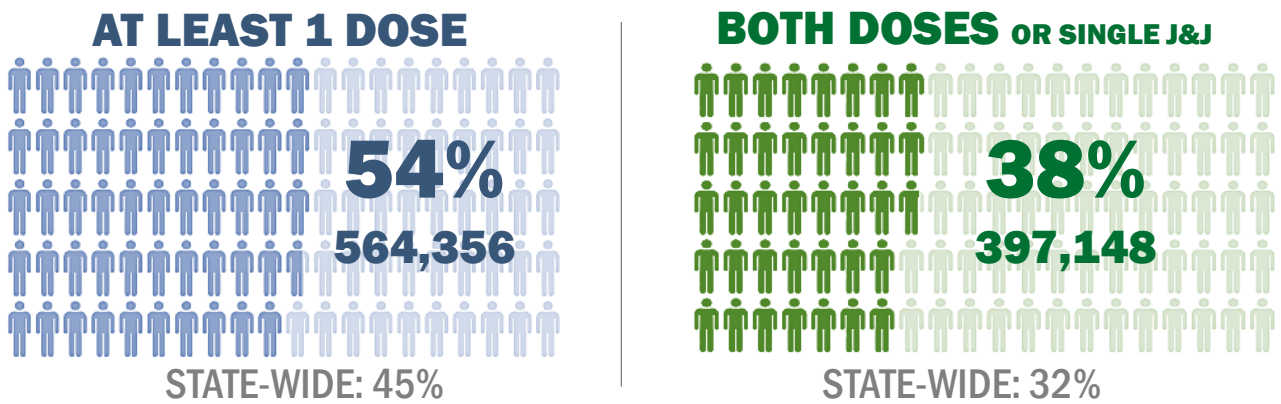

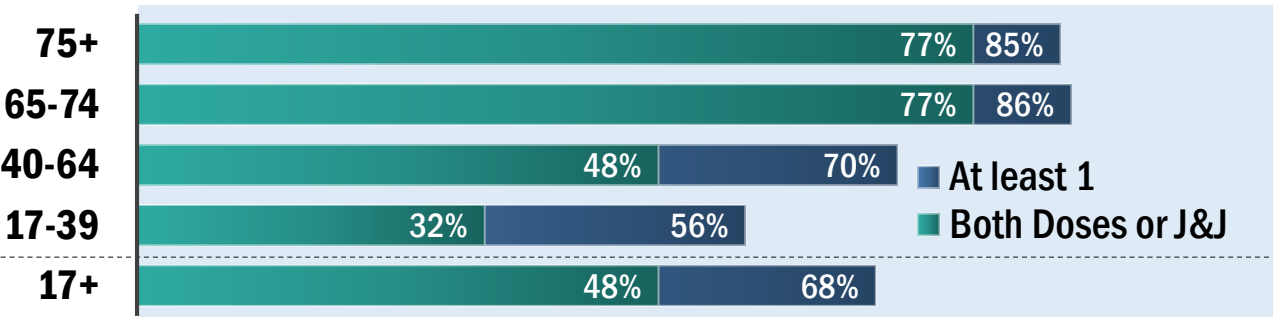

% OF COUNTY RESIDENTS VACCINATED BY AGE GROUP

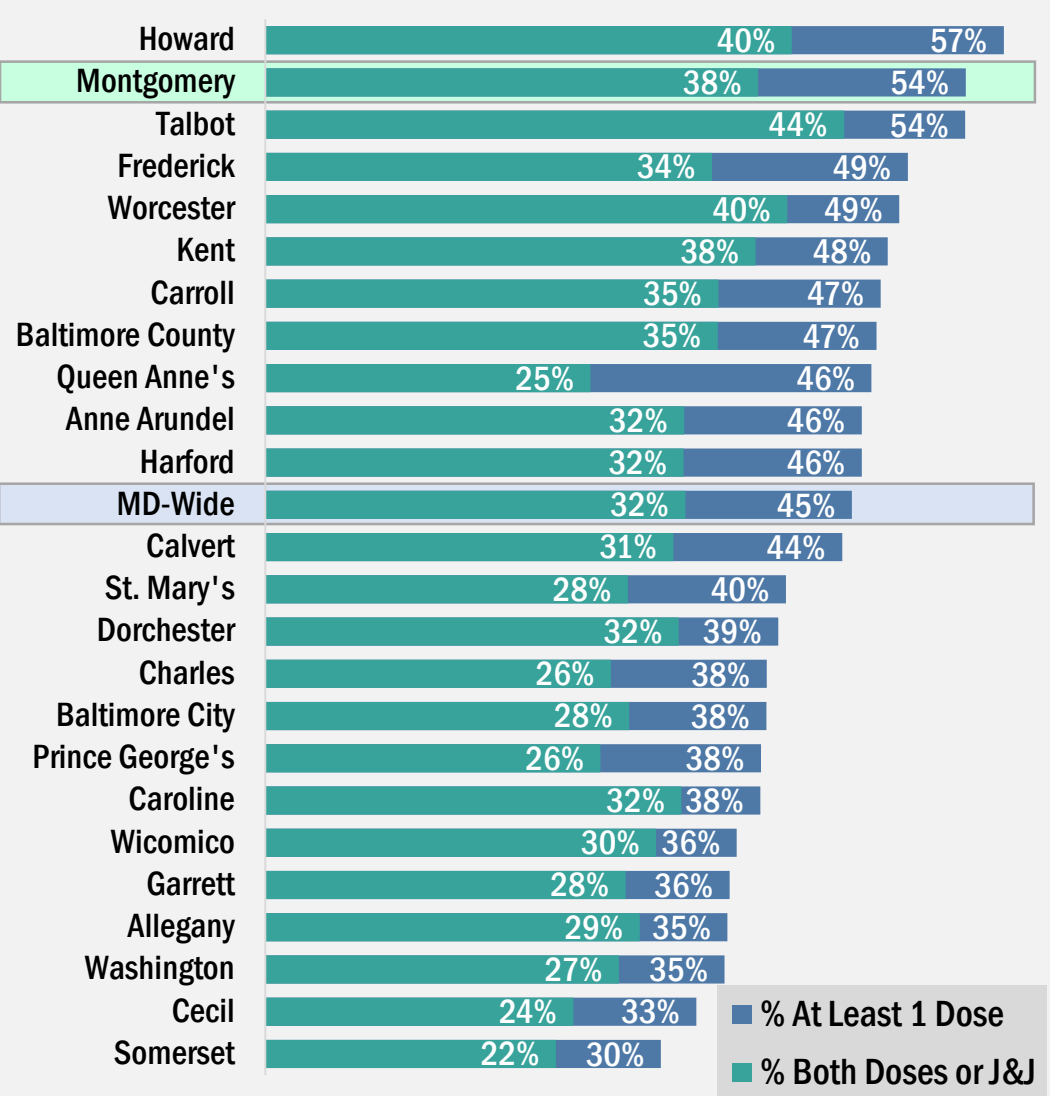


VAX TYPE FOR VACCINATED COUNTY RESIDENTS (1ST DOSE ONLY)

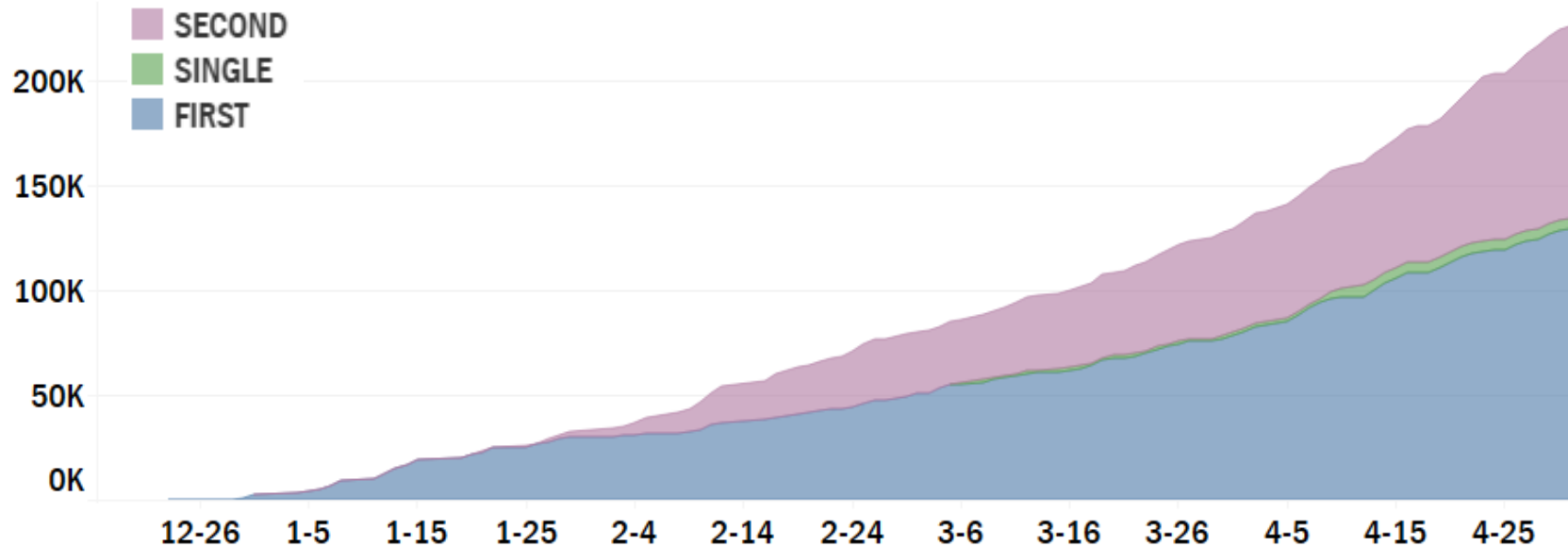

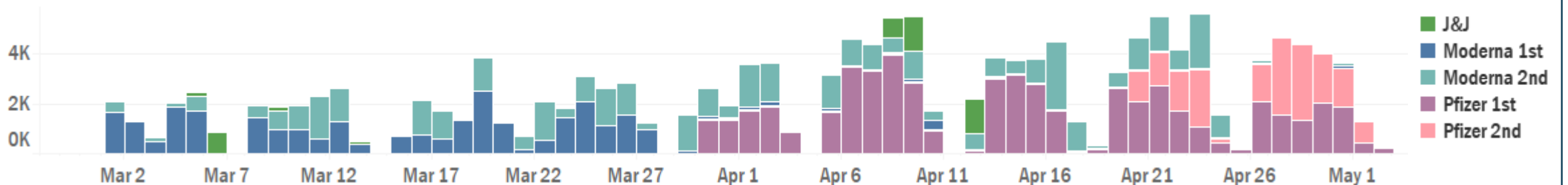

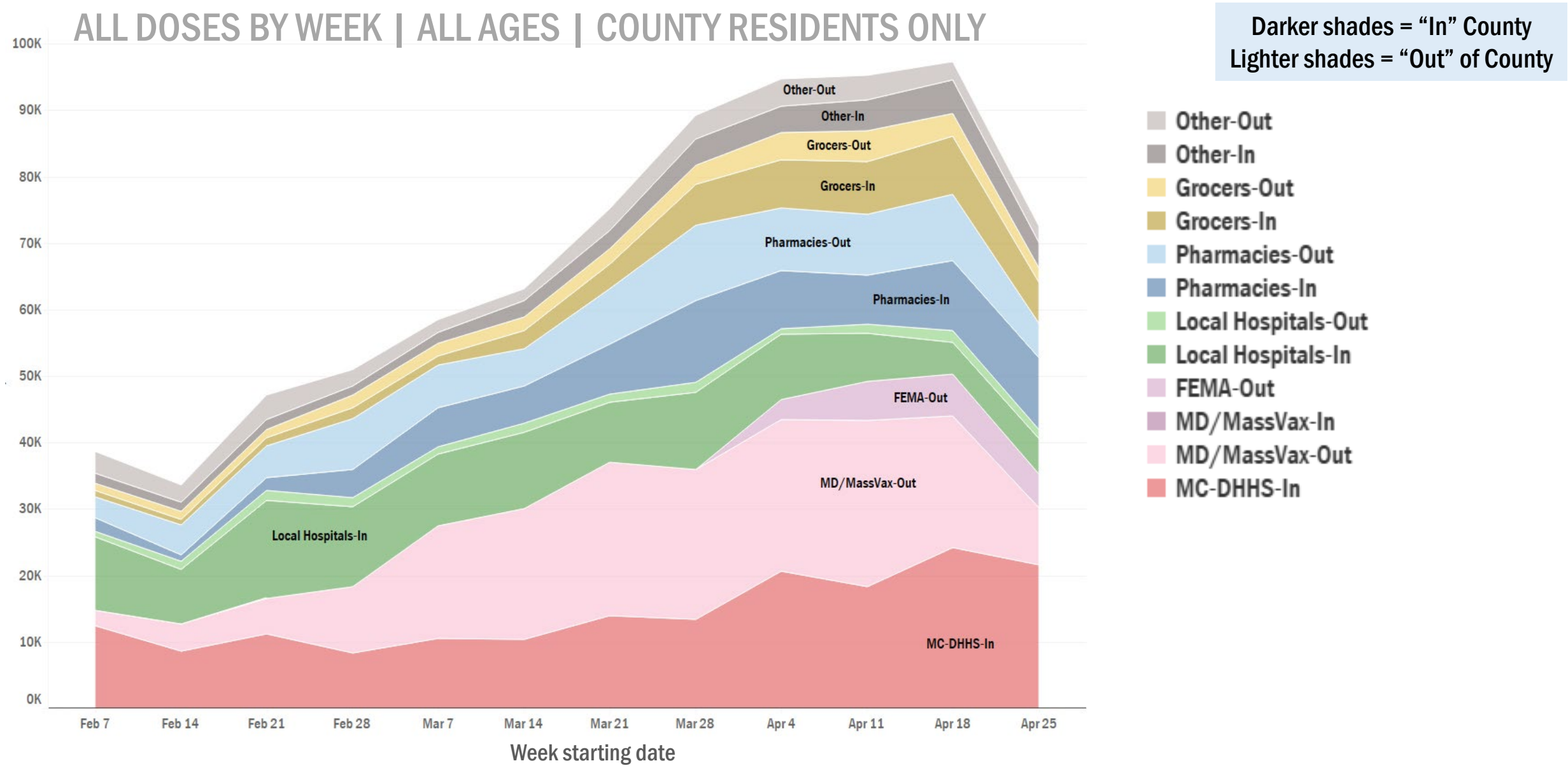

VACCINATIONS OF COUNTY RESIDENTS BY PROVIDER TYPE AND LOCATION

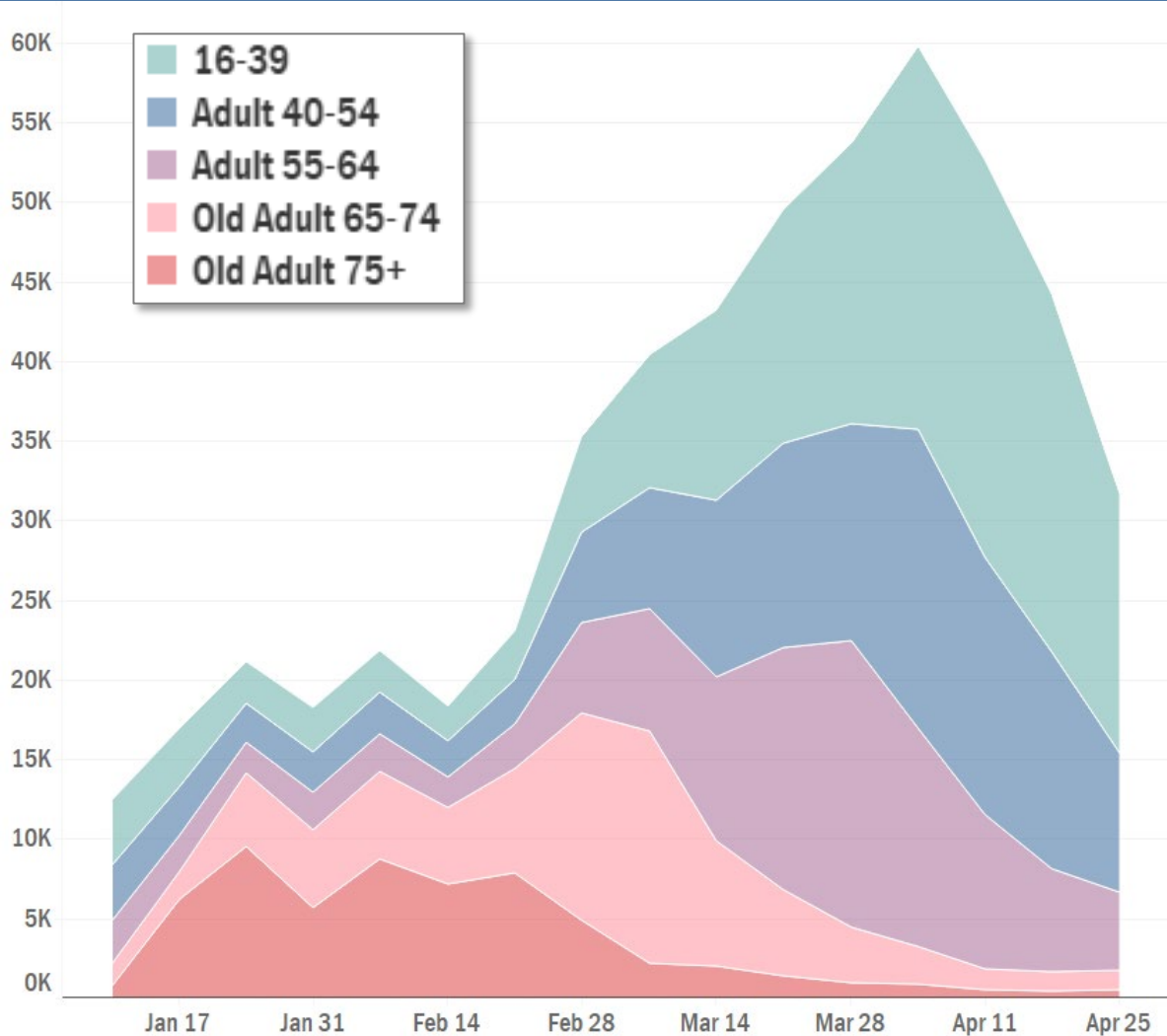

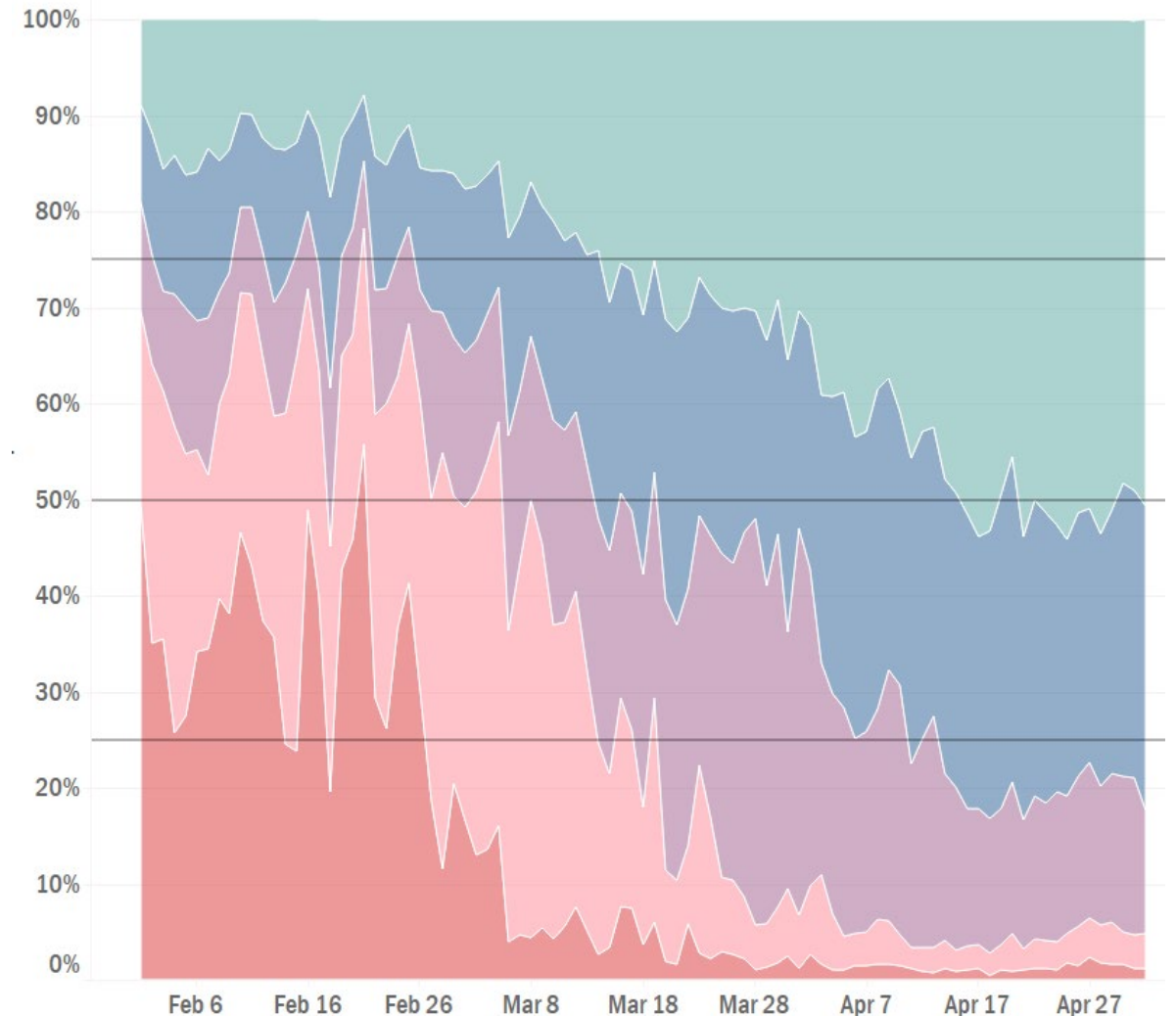
VACCINATIONS BY AGE GROUP: CHANGE OVER TIME

DISTRIBUTION BY WEEK - TOTAL COUNTS (1ST DOSE ONLY)

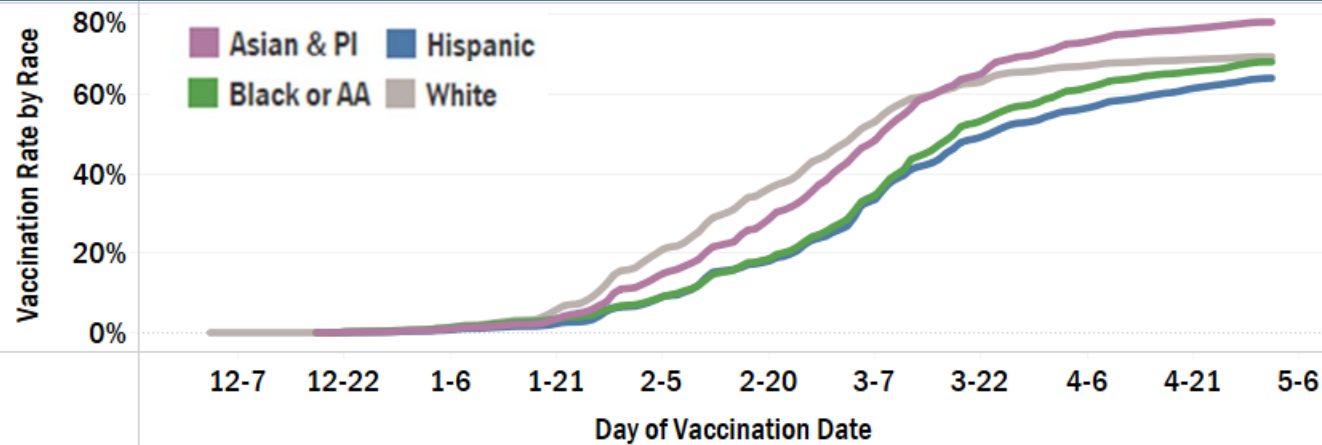


DISTRIBUTION BY DAY - % OF TOTAL (1ST DOSE ONLY)

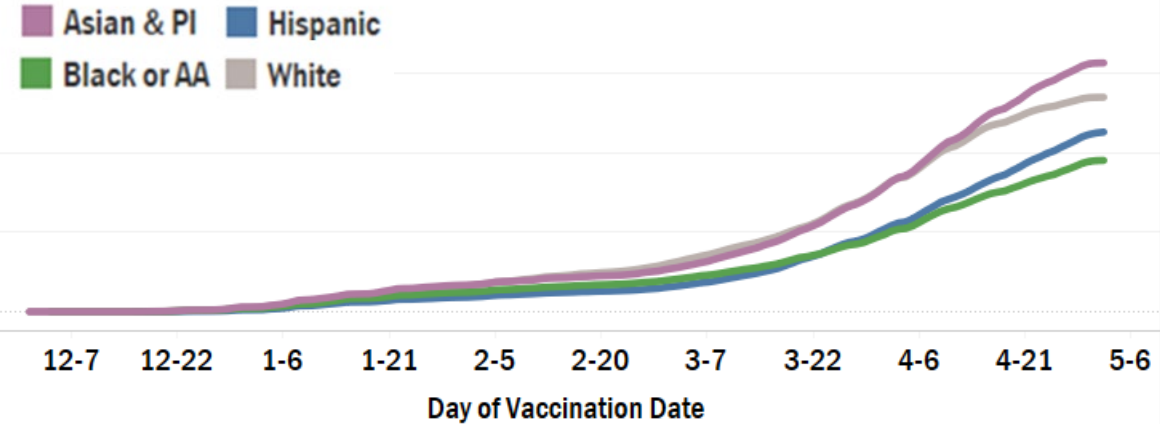


RELATIVE VACCINATION RATES OVER TIME BY RACE/ETHNICITY

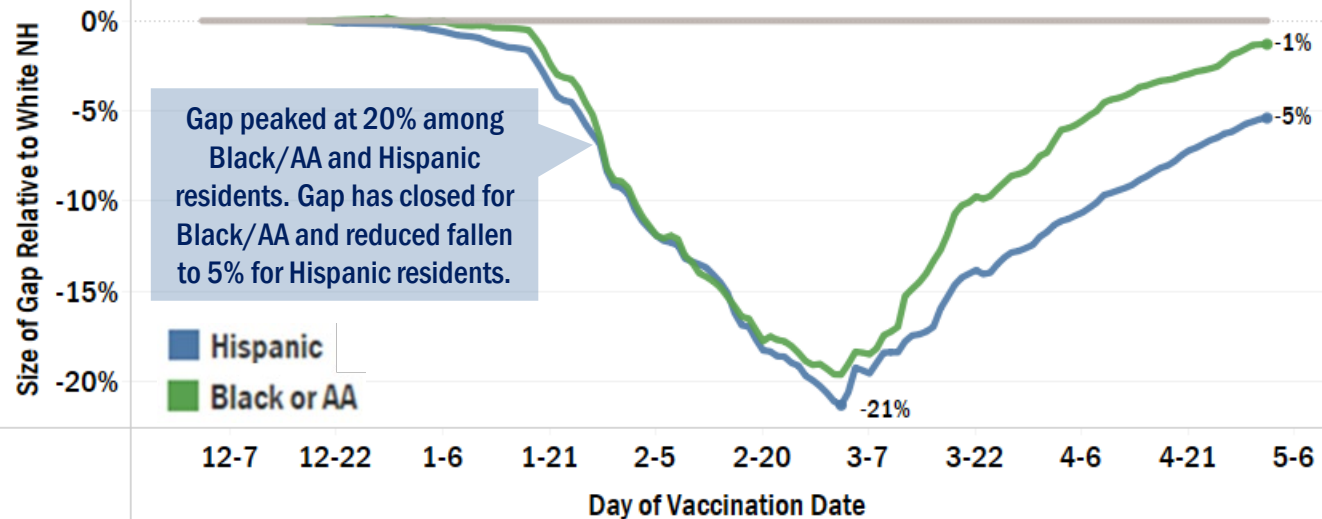
RELATIVE VACCINATION RATES: 65+



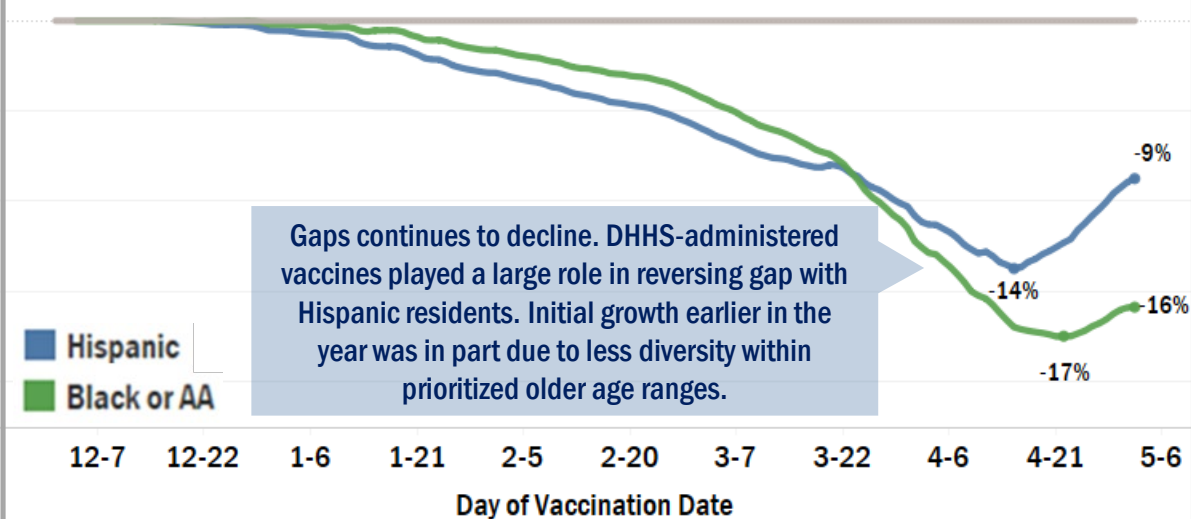
RELATIVE VACCINATION RATES: 16-64



GAP IN VACCINATION RATES RELATIVE TO WHITE (NH): 65+

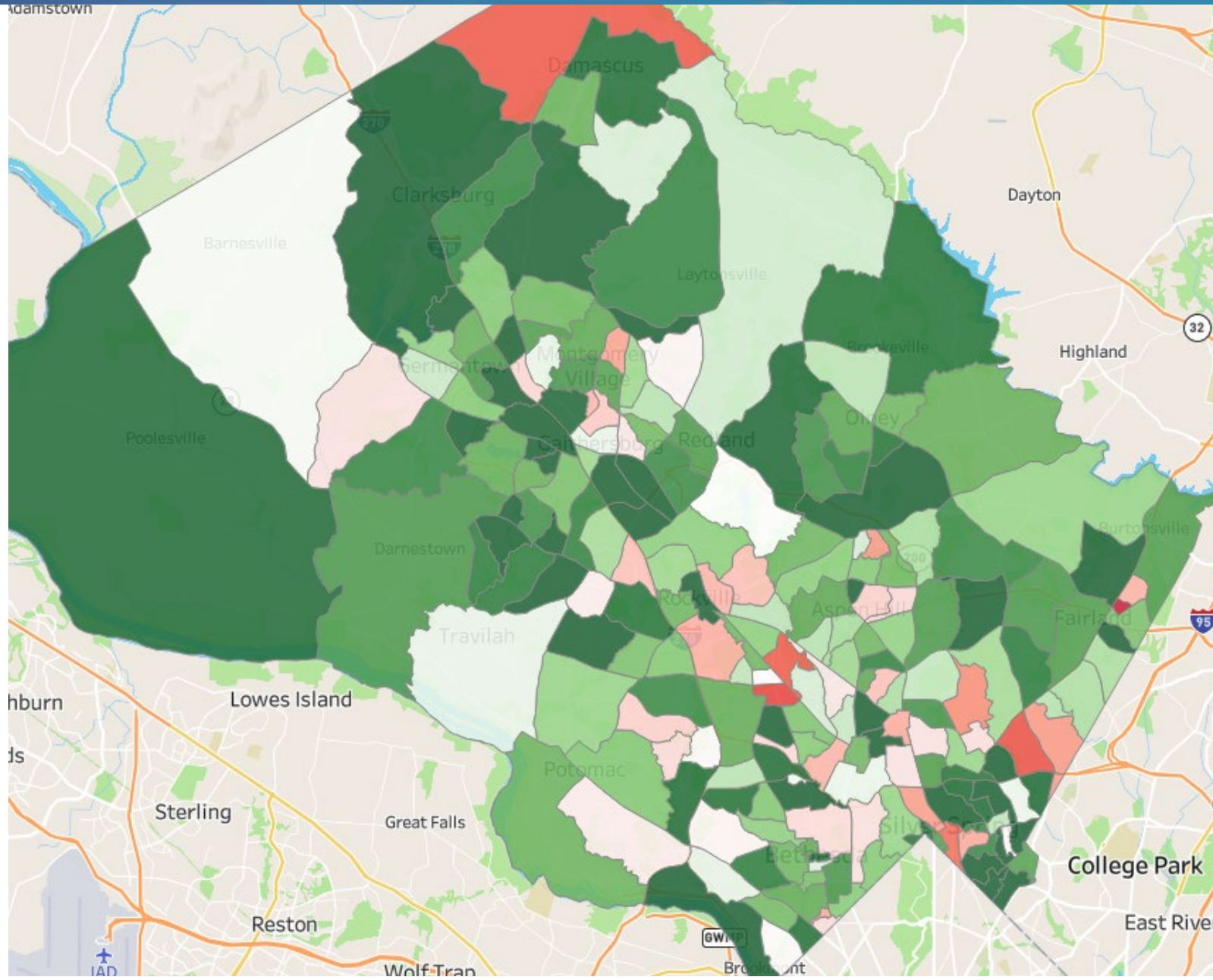


GAP IN VACCINATION RATES RELATIVE TO WHITE (NH): 16-64

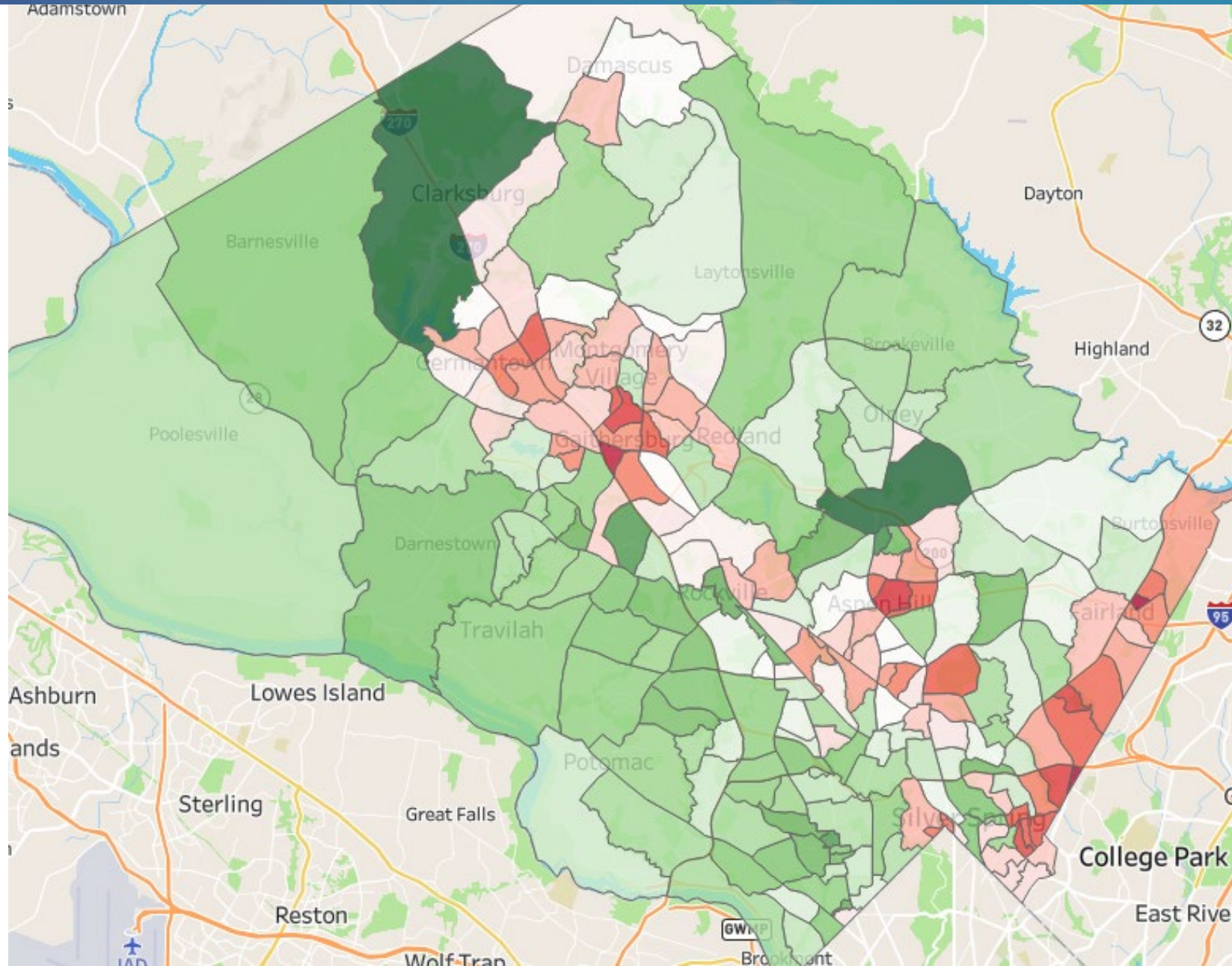

% OF UNDER 65 VACCINATED

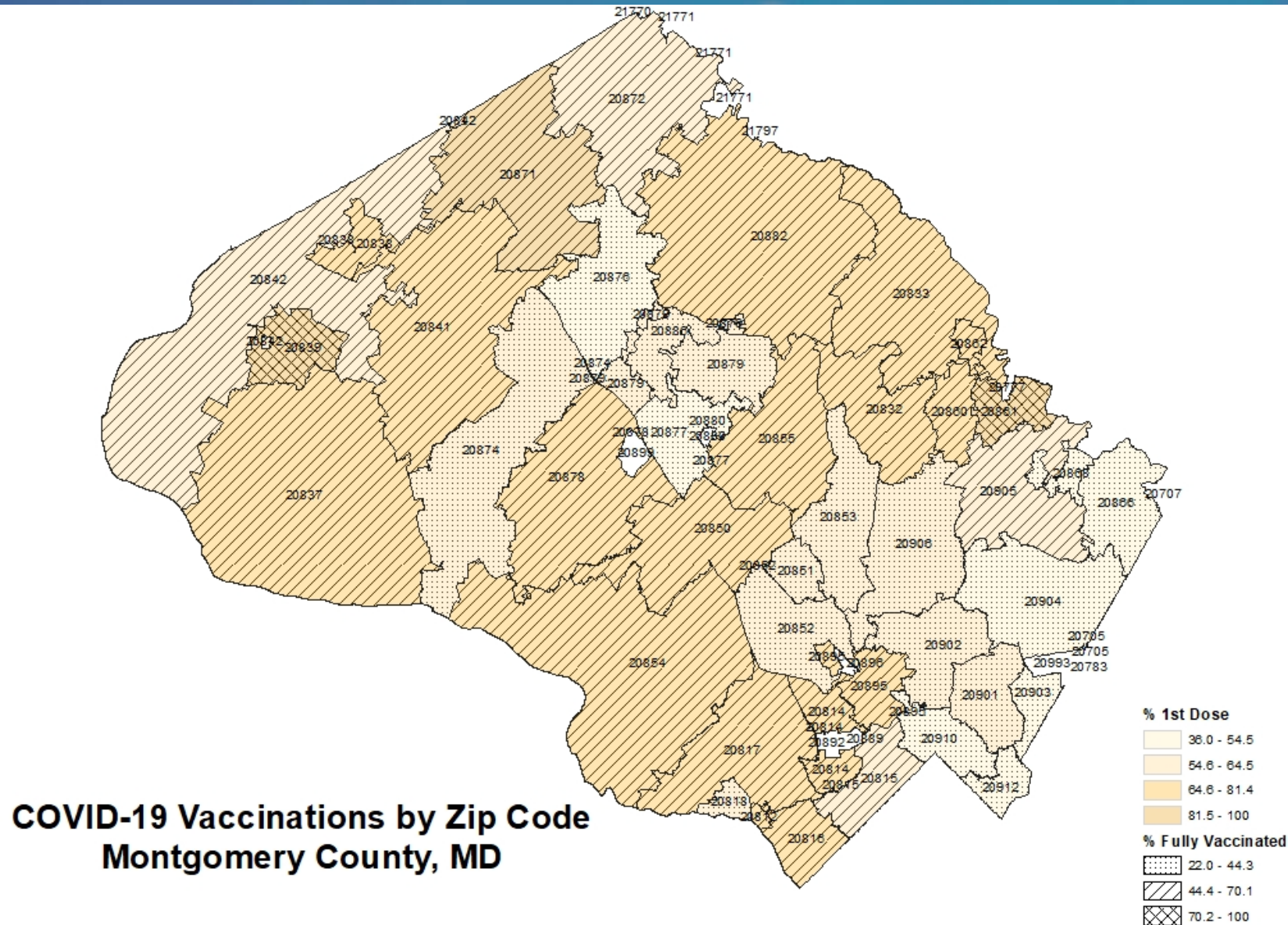

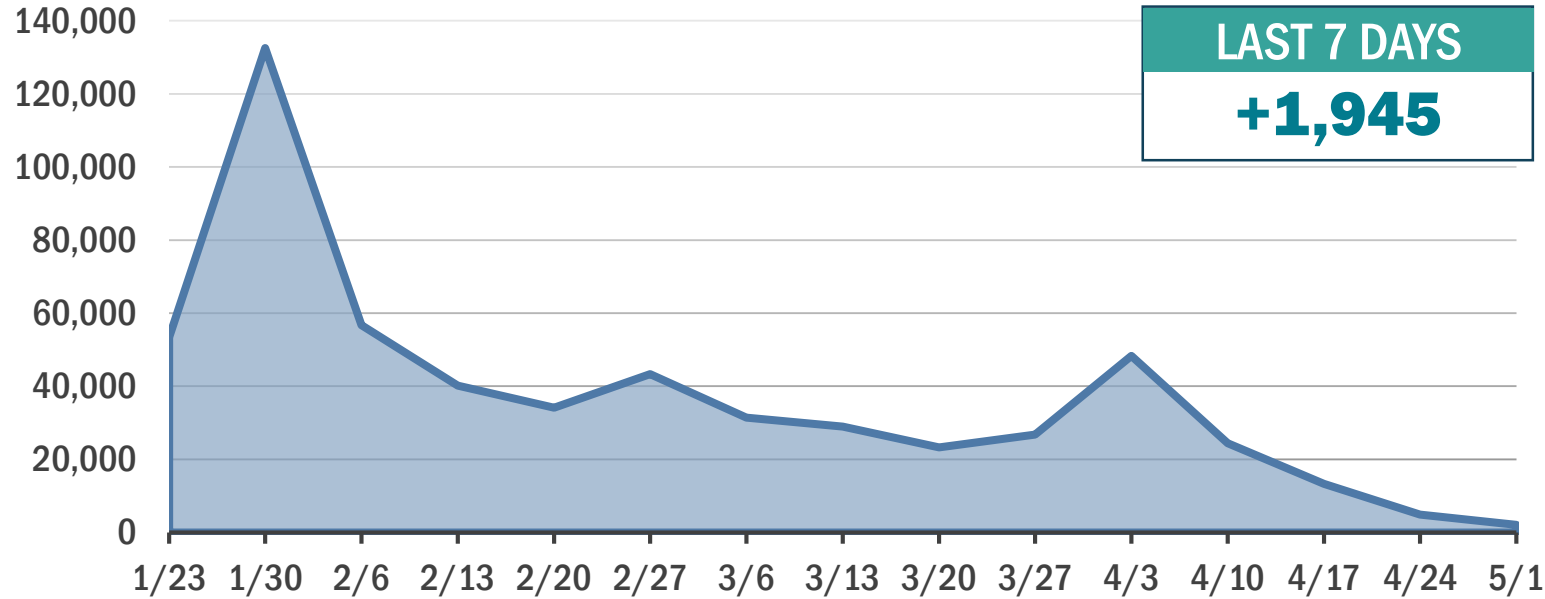

GEOGRAPHY: VACCINATIONS BY ZIP CODE (ALL AGES)

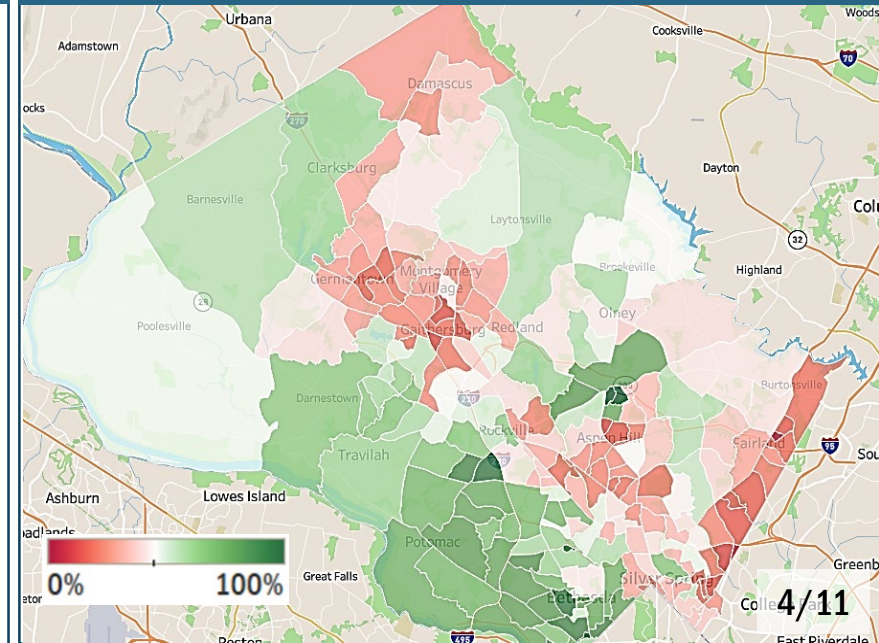

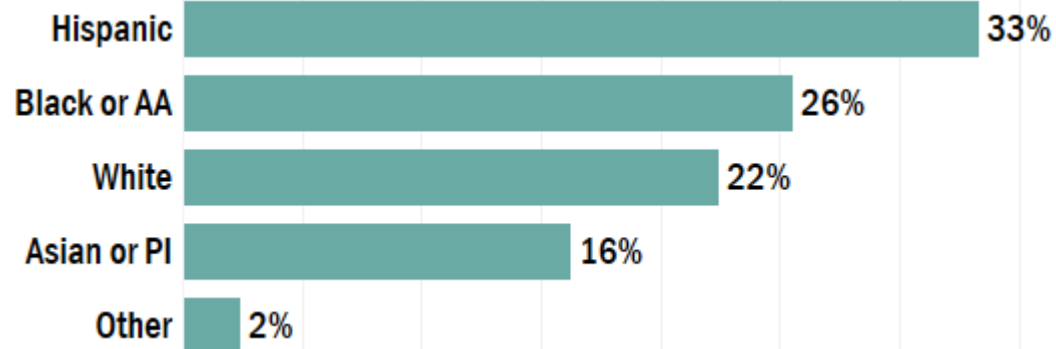
PRE-REGISTRATIONS BY WEEK



GEOGRAPHY: % OF POPULATION - ALL TIME

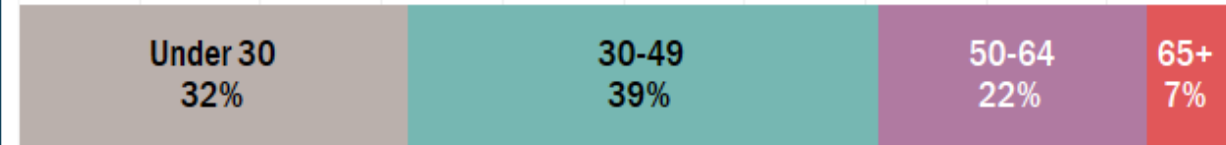


PRE-REGISTRATIONS BY RACE/ETHNICITY
