- I. Attendance and Administrative Items (6:30)
 - Carolyn Chen (CC) took attendance and Susan Farag (SF) began recording the meeting.

II. Discussion about Special Appropriation to the FY22 Operating Budget Department of Police, COVID-19 ARPA Relief Funds (\$731,125) (6:35)

- President Gabe Albornoz was present to answer questions of how the ARPA Relief funds were being utilized. It's to (1) build on existing infrastructure, (2) address some of the immediate needs for the summer, and (3) the hope is that if these programs and initiatives are successful, they will be included as a line item going into next year.
- Capt. Picerno discussed the intention of the Violent Information Crime Center under the ARPA Funds. Since it is becoming difficult to hire sworn officers on the street, tasks that can be done in the back will be completed by non-sworn officers. They will be analysts.

III. Guest Speaker – MCPD – Implicit Bias Training for Police (7:28)

- Capt. Amy Daum provided a presentation on the Implicit Bias training that is taught to the recruit class. She discussed, (1) the four types of biases, (2) the science behind the brain, and (3) scholars such as Malcolm Gladwell.
- Together, Capt. Daum and Capt. Clarke answered questions on the implicit bias training for police.
- Action: SF will follow up with Captain Picerno on data retention policy on excluded individuals.
- Action: SF will send Capt. Smith in the Personnel Division questions that are being asked in the beginning of employment to decide who should or should not enter the force.
- > Action: SF will send out the training that community Engagement Officers go through.
- Action: Dalbin will gather any follow-up questions and send them over to MCPD representatives.
