Is running a red light still enforced?

Two locations in particular, Georgia/Cameron and Georgia/Colesville I experience every single day someone running a red light. I don't mean disobeying no turn on red, which are hard to see so I can understand. I'm referring to running a red arrow. It endangers pedestrian safety. It is the most frequently observed dangerous driving behavior I see in Silver Spring and I hope it is enforced.

I don't care who or what enforces traffic so long as it is done fairly and we can see results. I can see the results of decreased traffic enforcement and it doesn't feel safe to walk or drive.

Lastly, is crowd sourced ticketing a potential avenue. In NYC I can see video of driving in bike lanes or idling for extended periods of time. I, for reporting the infraction, am given a cut of the ticket issued. Would Montgomery County be interested in a similar program? I think it would enhance community involvement and alter driving behavior in a safe and non-combative way. Don't really need the police to get involved at all with this option.
