Prisoner Medical Services NDA

Summary of April 15 Committee Worksession:

The Committee reviewed projected expenditures for FY12 and noted that the reimbursement costs are unpredictable. There were no questions. For FY12, the County Executive is recommending \$40,000 in funding for this NDA. This NDA provides reimbursements for medical costs incurred by persons under arrest but not under the custody of the Department of Correction and Rehabilitation. The Department of Police administers this NDA. The spending history for this NDA is:

The costs for this responsibility are unpredictable. Annual expenditures over the past 10 years have ranged from a low of \$647 in FY06 up to a high of \$99,611 in FY10. The County will have to provide for whatever costs are incurred no matter how much is in the initial budget of this NDA. While FY09 and FY10 have exceeded the appropriation, a majority of the last ten years has been below this amount. Council staff recommends approval of \$40,000, as submitted by the Executive.
