It recently has come to my attention that the Montgomery County Council is considering a 4.5% tax increase to the property tax. I am writing to urge you to not implement a proposed tax increase at this time.

While I do not live in Montgomery County, I was born in the county and have many friends in the county. As a candidate for Congress in Congressional District #6, I am working with several Montgomery County residents and would like to present their views to you.

Under normal circumstances, a tax increase of this kind could be debated without people worrying about going out in public because of the Covid-19Epidemic. In addition, many people throughout Montgomery County and District 6 are hurting financially.

The unemployment rate is at its highest level in recent memory. Numerous small businesses across Montgomery County have shut down; many will likely never be able to open their doors again. Families are struggling to make ends meet, and many people are concerned about losing their homes.
