I bowl in BWYTL which is the travel youth league for duckpin bowling that goes to White Oak every other Sunday. I am 19 years old and have noticed the craziness going on in the world and I have been very impressed by White Oak Lanes' attempt to keep everyone safe. Unlike every other bowling alley I have been to during COVID-19, White Oak has always enforced wearing masks, are constantly cleaning all surfaces (including bowling balls), and they even take our temperatures every time that we go there for extra safety. When we bowl there they make us space out more than normal. So 2 teams bowl on 1 and 2 and another 2 teams bowl on 5 and 6. Skipping 2 lanes provides a table per team and a seating area per team unlike pre-COVID-19 times. Overall, out of every bowling alley I have gone to, I have felt the most comfortable and safest at White Oak Lanes. Considering this, I believe it would be ridiculous to reduce the capacity to 25 because they are doing flawlessly right now and have provided so much fun while prioritizing safety. White Oak Lanes is doing everything they can to be safe so there capacity should not be reduced.
