In times of fear and uncertainty, policy and decision makers have a heightened responsibility to lead from a position of data and sound scientific analysis. In the absence of this, decision-making can quickly succumb to emotion, or worse political ideology.

Once aware of the proposed orders contained in Executive Order No 122-20 I have sought to find the data and analysis that was used as its foundation. My searches have turned up empty. I do not want to assume that the County Council would proceed with these changes without data, but given recent history, I have my doubts. I am soliciting the Council to 1)make publicly available the data and analysis used to inform the language in the executive order, and 2)postpone decision making on the Executive Order till a point at which the public can reasonably review the data and hold a well-informed discussion with the Council.

Below I have outlined questions pertaining to the policy changes for Child Care that are in need of data:

- 1. Since re-opening daycares in Montgomery County, what is the total number of positive cases of children under the age of 9 who are enrolled at a daycare facility in Montgomery County?
- 2. Since re-opening daycares, what is the total number of positive cases of day care workers employed at a daycare facility in Montgomery County?
- 3. How many children who tested positive and attend a daycare have traced their source of exposure to a positive case within the daycare they attend?
- 4. How many day care workers who tested positive have traced their source of exposure to a positive case within the daycare they are employed at?
- 5. Across Montgomery County, how many positive cases (child or adult) have been traced to a child that goes to daycare or to an individual employed by a daycare?
- 6. What is the current number of adults, across Montgomery County, that can identify their source of exposure to someone under the age of 9 years old?
- 7. Across Montgomery County, how many positive cases exist in which a person traces their source of exposure to an asymptomatic individual? How many involve an asymptomatic child under the age of 9?
- 8. What is the anticipated number of new unemployment claims filed by Maryland County residents if this order is in effect for 60 days? How about for 90 days?
- 9. What is the anticipated number of daycare business within Montgomery County that will shutdown if this order is in effect for 60 days? How about 90 days?
- 10. What do you anticipate/forecast to be the reduction in number of cases for children under the age of 9 across Montgomery County by reducing capacity to 50%?
- 11. What do you anticipate/forecast to be the reduction in number of hospitalizations for children under the age of 9 across Montgomery County by reducing capacity to 50%?
- 12. What do you anticipate/forecast to be the reduction in TOTAL number of cases across Montgomery County by reducing capacity to 50%?
- 13. What do you anticipate/forecast to be the reduction in TOTAL number of hospitalizations across Montgomery County by reducing capacity to 50%
