Subject: Rollback of Customers at Bowl America Gaithersburg

Bowl America Gaithersburg should receive an exemption on the rollback to 25 people. Since reopening 6 weeks ago, there has been NO cases on any team or individual of Covid-19. The staff is going to be furloughed once again right before the holidays. Frederick is now allowing their bowling center to operate at 75% capacity as of Nov 9th. I ask for consideration for an exemption for a job well done, otherwise the center will close down if attendance drops to 25 people, as it's not profitable to operate a 4600 square foot building with staff for little revenue.
