- We already have reduced hours due to COVID. We are open Wednesday Saturday 9:00 a.m. –
 8:00 p.m.
- My 25% capacity is 48 dinners. We have not had mor then 28 diners at the same time and that was back in November before the reduction.
- I still have beer, wine and liquor from March on hand so that tells you how much business we are doing.
- Please wait until January when biasness normally slows down and the impact will be lessened.
- Do you really believe eating in an enclosed tent is safer? We have better ventilation then a tent.
- You are just driving diners to other counties. I have been conversing with Howard County Restaurateurs and they are busy with 50% capacity.
- In-door dining closure will cost 5 JOBS! 2 servers, 1 bartender, 2 cooks.
- I announced Saturday if in-door dining is closed I will no longer be able to pay Health Insurance for my 5 full time employees.
- Unemployment for many runs out December 26. Those that I am laying off as of the announcement will not have an income.
- My sales now are only running 30% of last year. We are already losing over \$100,000 in Holiday Party Sales.
- You know where the Hot Spots are, Shut them down.
- One size fits all policy does not work.
- Have you considered looking at alcohol Purchases for those that may be over capacity?
- Have you considered mandatory posting of Max Capacity as part of the Policy on the Entrances so Customers know how many should be dining?
