The Washington Post dated March 16, 2023 discussed the proposed tax hike on Montgomery County residents' property tax in order to cover schools' needs. I propose that the property tax for Seniors should not be raised for this purpose. Seniors, including myself and my husband, need tax relief and NOT a tax hike. Please consider raising the taxes for those individuals who are younger than 65 years old. Several counties in the US separate tax solely for property and the property tax portion to fund schools.
