In order to make progress in ending homelessness, there are some key programs that need <u>increased</u> funding to add more services: these include **Permanent Supportive Housing**, the **Housing Initiative Program**, and the **Rapid Rehousing Program**.

In addition, investing more in **affordable housing** for the deeply low income is vital to reverse the shortage that affects our community.

I also support increased funding for **Emergency Rental Assistance** as a safety net for families.

I also support increased funding for the **Crisis Center** so that it can be staffed 24/7 for all three sites, in Rockville, Germantown and Silver Spring. Mental health emergencies require trained behavioral health experts county-wide 24/7.
