Arcola's CSC, Ms. Emily Fuentes, and CSL, Mrs. Heather Hunter, are both extremely involved with the school and our community and we've seen their increase in services greatly benefit a school population that live below the poverty line, with many that don't speak English, and others that are at risk or have family issues.

If anything, Mrs. Fuentes and Mrs. Hunter need raises for their ever-increasing workload. County Executive March Ehrlich is supporting a larger MCPS budget that increase funds per pupil and I'd like to think those funds will support the extremely beneficial services that Arcola's CSC and CSL provide. There is absolutely no way these two important positions can be consolidated into one without damaging the high-impact, value added services Ms. Fuentes and Mrs. Hunter bring to our Arcola Gator Community.
