My name is Jennifer Young, and I live at United Methodist Church (FUMC) located at 680 Montrose Road, where I serve on the Resources Committee. I am writing to support the passage of the Faith Zoning Text Amendment (ZTA) that would make developing affordable housing on properties owned by faith organizations.

While I do not speak for the church as a whole, I am part of the FUMC leadership team that is exploring the idea of building affordable housing on Faith's property. We have completed a feasibility study performed by a Georgetown Masters in Real Estate candidate, which shows what you all know to be true – that there is a great demand in Montgomery County for affordable housing.
