I'm writing to encourage the County Council's continued support for Montgomery Community Media (MCM). (Disclosure: I serve as a member of MCM's board of directors)

As you know, local public media outlets across the country are facing real funding challenges due to steeply declining revenues tied to cable television subscriptions.
