DD-Supplement change: FY25, \$21,694,859 to FY26, \$22,344,859

Dear Council Members:

We are writing on behalf of the 41 InterACC providers who provide close to 4,000 services to Montgomery County residents with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities (IDD). These services include residential, supported living, day, community development, and personal support in their home and community. In addition to these services, many of the people we support also receive housing support, behavioral support, nursing support, and peer and family mentoring services.

We are facing uncharted territory, even though the State restored revenue to avoid the catastrophic cuts for FY25 and FY26, InterACC providers will still experience deeper cuts than most DD providers. Additionally, it remains unclear whether Medicaid will come unscathed as Congress moves towards a budget resolution.

The close to fifty-year partnership between Montgomery County and InterACC becomes more crucial as we begin to navigate these uncharted waters over the next few years. InterACC is here and looks forward to working with the County Executive and County Council members to assure that people with IDD continue to receive:

- High quality person-centered services.
- DSP wages continue to increase even during tough times
- Turnover rates continue to trend down

The continual support and funding for the DD-Supplement are needed more than ever to ensure that we do not lose all of the momentum that we have gained over the last few years.

InterACC is requesting that the County Council support the County Executive's proposed increase of 3% to the DD-Supplement.

Montgomery County citizens with IDD, their families, DSP support staff, and DD-providers want to thank you for your years of support.
