I urge the County Council to vote against the requested amendment to our zoning laws (ZTA 25-06) which changes the set back requirements for the location of large gas stations. Those existing requirements are science-based and were put in place for the health of our citizens. They do not lend themselves to adjustment for convenience at a particular location, and adjusting them to accommodate a specific location or council member's interests sets a dangerous precedence that puts all of our communities potentially at risk.
