The purpose of the meeting was to update the Airpark Liaison Committee on the Environmental Assessment Study for the Montgomery County Airpark. Roy Lewis, Project Manager from Delta Airport Consultants, Inc. gave a power point presentation on the latest phase of the study.

Airport Layout Plan (ALP)

The Study does not recommend any expansion at the Airpark beyond what is required by the FAA.

Environmental Assessment Proposed Projects

- 1) Obstruction Removal
- 2) Property Acquisition
- 3) Lower Access Road and Parking Lot
- 4) Install Holding Position Signage and Marking (RW/TW intersections)
- 5) Install Precision Approach Path Indicators (PAPI) on Runway 14

Alternative Analysis

Alternatives required to be evaluated in the EA:

- Alternative 1: No Action
- Alternative 2: Achieve FAA Design Standards
 - Access road must be lowered
 - Tree line removed

Property Interest Acquisition – Runway 14 End

Purpose: Runway Protection Zone Control

Obstruction Removal - Trees

Property is owned by the County but used by Park and Planning. Title must change to the Revenue Authority to meet FAA requirements

Property Interest Acquisition - Runway 32 End

Purpose: Runway Protection Zone Control

Obstruction Removal – Trees, Terrain, & Buildings

Lower Access Road and Parking Lot

Revenue Authority Management of the Airpark
