COUNCILMEMBERS DENIS & ANDREWS TO SLAM PROPOSED \$350 AMBULANCE FEE AT MONDAY NEWS CONFERENCE

Councilmembers Howard Denis and Phil Andrews will hold a news conference on Monday morning in Bethesda to announce their opposition to a proposal by County Executive Doug Duncan to impose a \$350 ambulance fee on County residents.

The proposal, which has triggered hundreds of letters and e-mails opposed and not a single letter in favor, will be acted on by the Council early next year.

Joining Denis and Andrews – who chairs the Council's Public Safety Committee – will be Fire & Rescue volunteers and concerned citizens.
