## COUNTY COUNCIL FOR MONTGOMERY COUNTY, MARYLAND

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**AN EXPEDITED ACT** to:

- (1) authorize the transfer of certain funds from one parking lot district to another; and
- (2) generally amend the law governing parking lot districts.

By amending

Chapter 60, Silver Spring, Bethesda, Wheaton and Montgomery Hills Parking Lot  
Districts  
Section 60-16, Purpose of parking lot funds

*The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following Act:*

1           **Sec. 1. Section 60-16 is amended as follows:**

2   **60-16.       Purpose of parking lot funds.**

3   \*    \*    \*

4           (f)   (1)   Notwithstanding the limits in subsection (a) or (b) or any other  
5   provision of this Chapter, the County Council may authorize  
6   the transfer of revenue from parking fees collected in a parking  
7   lot district in any fiscal year to temporarily fund the operations  
8   of another parking lot district. In this subsection, "parking fee"  
9   means revenue from parking meters, parking permits, or any  
10   other user charge for parking.

11   (2)   The Council must approve any transfer under this subsection in  
12   the resolution approving the district's annual operating budget  
13   or in a separate resolution. Each transfer of funds must be  
14   conditioned on a reasonable repayment agreement. Each  
15   authorizing resolution must specify:

16   (A)   the purposes for which the transferred funds may be  
17   used; and

18   (B)   the terms of repayment to the originating parking lot  
19   district.

20           **Sec. 2.       Expedited Effective Date.**   The Council declares that this  
21   legislation is necessary for the immediate protection of the public interest. This  
22   Act takes effect on July 1, 2014, and applies to any fiscal year that begins on or  
23   after that date.




