- Sec. 1. Section 2A-7 is amended as follows:
- 2 **2A-7. Pre-hearing procedures.**
- 3 \* \*
- (d) Summary Decision. Any party may file a motion for summary decision
  at least 20 days before the date of a hearing. The hearing authority may
  grant summary decision if the hearing authority finds that there is no
  genuine issue of material fact to be decided at the hearing. The hearing
  authority must give all other parties at least 10 days to respond to the
  motion for summary decision before deciding the motion. The hearing
  authority may permit oral argument on the motion.
- Restrictions on data. Unless a matter has been formally certified for 11 (e) 12 hearing by the hearing authority, government documents or records shall not be subject to these provisions. In the event a matter is certified for 13 hearing by the hearing authority, any documents or records not to be used 14 15 at the hearing shall not be subject to the provisions of this chapter. 16 Further, any matter or materials which are designated by law as 17 confidential shall not be released without a waiver of the parties to the confidentiality. 18
