SUBJECT: Special Appropriation to the FY16 Capital Budget
Montgomery County Public Schools
Technology Modernization, \$2,000,000

Background

1. Section 308 of the County Charter provides that a special appropriation is an appropriation which states that it is necessary to meet an unforeseen disaster or other emergency, or to act without delay in the public interest. Each special appropriation shall be approved by not less than six Councilmembers. The Council may approve a special appropriation at any time after public notice by news release. Each special appropriation shall specify the source of funds to finance it.
2. The Board of Education requested a special appropriation for the Montgomery County Public Schools' Technology Modernization FY16 capital project as follows:

3. This appropriation is needed because the County Council programmed an additional \$2 million in the MCPS Technology Modernization program to provide general support for technology in the MCPS budget, given that the Board of Education would need to make reductions to its operating budget to meet available resources. The Council programmed these funds as part of its budget action in May, but did not appropriate the funds pending Board of Education consideration and request of the appropriation.
4. Notice of public hearing was given and a public hearing was held.


Action
