**SUBJECT:** Reappointment of the Director Office of Legislative Oversight

**Background**


1. Section 29A, Montgomery County Code, establishes the Office of Legislative Oversight to serve as the principal means through which the County Council exercises its legislative oversight functions.
2. Section 1A-204(b)(2) of the Montgomery County Code specifies that the Office of Legislative Oversight will be headed by a Director, who shall be a non-merit employee appointed by a majority of Councilmembers in office.
3. Section 1A-204(b)(2) further specifies that, beginning January 1, 1988, the term of the Director is four years; that there is no limit to the number of terms that a director may serve; and that if the Council has not appointed a successor when a director's term expires, the director continues to serve until an appointed successor assumes office.
4. The Council, by Resolution 17-429, appointed Christopher Cihlar to his first four-year term.

**Action**

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, approves the following resolution:

Christopher Cihlar is reappointed to the position of Director of the Office of Legislative Oversight, subject to the conditions provided by law. His current salary is \$164,250. This four-year term will expire December 31, 2019.
