SUBJECT: Resolution to Support an Application submitted by Mobile Medical Care, Inc. to obtain \$20,000 in Tax Credits

Background

1. The State of Maryland's Department of Housing and Community Development (MDDHCD) has established the Community Investment Tax Credit Program.
2. The Community Investment Tax Credit Program (CITC) is a part of the Smart Growth initiative designed to promote efforts to support a variety of projects for special populations, to provide a source of funds for assistance, and to support projects undertaken by the nonprofit sector.
3. CITC provides tax credits to corporations that donate funds to nonprofit organizations that provide services and projects to special populations throughout the state.
4. Montgomery County supports the provision of quality primary health care for all County residents including low-income, unemployed, or uninsured populations.
5. Mobile Medical Care, Inc. (Mobile Med), a nonprofit organization, has been established in the County for over 45 years with a primary mission of providing high quality primary health care services to low income populations with compassion, respect and cultural sensitivity.
6. Mobile Med has applied to MDDHCD for an allocation of \$20,000 in tax credits for business entities that make contributions.
7. Mobile Med proposes to use tax credit proceeds to continue their expansion of health care services in three Maryland Priority Areas: Aspen Hill, Rockville and Fairland.
8. The County Executive and the County Council support the project and the application of Mobile Medical Care, Inc. for \$20,000 in tax credits. This support is given as specified in COMAR 5.14.01.05B(10)(a).

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following Resolution:

Montgomery County supports the project and the application of Mobile Medical Care, Inc. for an allocation of tax credit funds under the Community Investment Tax Credit Program.
