Background

- 1. Section 307 of the Montgomery County Charter provides that any supplemental appropriation shall be recommended by the County Executive who shall specify the source of funds to finance it. The Council shall hold a public hearing on each proposed supplemental appropriation after at least one week's notice. A supplemental appropriation that would comply with, avail the County of, or put into effect a grant or a Federal, State or County law or regulation, or one that is approved after January 1 of any fiscal year, requires an affirmative vote of five Councilmembers. A supplemental appropriation for any other purpose that is approved before January 1 of any fiscal year requires an affirmative vote of six Councilmembers. The Council may, in a single action, approve more than one supplemental appropriation. The Executive may disapprove or reduce a supplemental appropriation, and the Council may reapprove the appropriation, as if it were an item in the annual budget.
- 2. Section 302 of the Montgomery County Charter provides that the Council may amend an approved capital improvements program at any time by an affirmative vote of no fewer than six members of the Council.
- 3. The County Executive recommends the following capital project appropriation increases:

4. This increase is needed because the Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) is past its useful life and no longer meets current National Fire Protection Association standards. The warranties have expired, resulting in higher maintenance costs and difficulty finding replacement parts. The recommended amendment is consistent with the criteria for amending the CIP because it addresses an urgent safety concern and to implement prior decisions.

- 5. The County Executive recommends an amendment to the FY17-22 Capital Improvements Program and a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$9,360,000 for Master Lease: Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (No. 311701), and specifies that the source of funds will be Short-Term Lease Financing.
- 6. Notice of public hearing was given and a public hearing was held.
