1. **Bill 46-15**, Human Rights and Civil Liberties – Building Maintenance Worker – Minimum Work Week was introduced on November 17, 2015. **Bill 46-15** was sponsored by Lead Sponsor Councilmember Riemer and Co-Sponsors Councilmembers Navarro, Elrich and Hucker.
2. Unless extended by the Council under Council Rule 6(f), the Bill will expire on May 17, 2017.
