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**SUBJECT:** Extension of Expiration Date of Bill 20-16, Purchases from Minority Owned Businesses – Enforcement of Subcontracting Plan - Request for Proposals – Amendments

**Background**


1. Bill 20-16, Purchases from Minority Owned Businesses – Enforcement of Subcontracting Plan – Request for Proposals - Amendments was introduced on May 17, 2016. Bill 20-16 was sponsored by Lead Sponsor Councilmember Rice and Co-Sponsors Councilmembers Leventhal, Navarro, then-Vice President Berliner, Councilmembers Elrich, Hucker, Katz, Riemer and then-Council President Floreen.
2. A public hearing on Bill 20-16 was held on June 21, 2016.
3. The Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee held a worksession on Bill 20-16 on June 30, 2016 and recommended to delay action on the Bill for 1 year to give the current formula more time to see how it affects awards to MFD prime contractors. Absent an extension, Bill 20-16 will expire on November 17, 2017.

**Action**

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The expiration date of Bill 20-16, Purchases from Minority Owned Businesses – Enforcement of Subcontracting Plan – Request for Proposals - Amendments, is extended to December 31, 2018.
