Resolution 18-1144, Section G, Fiscal Year 2019 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award Status: Montgomery Housing Partnership

Background

- 1. Section 11B-14 (a) (4) of the Montgomery County Code states that "a contract may be awarded without competition if the Chief Administrative Officer makes a written determination that the contract award serves a public purpose and proposed contractor has been identified in a grant or appropriation resolution approved by the Council." The result of this action is to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award status resolution to include the agency listed below.
- 2. The Chief Administrative Officer has determined that funding for the contract with this entity serves a public purpose and that such an expense would be in the public interest.
- 3. The Office of the County Executive (CEX) will fund the contract with the provider listed below from existing appropriations for FY 2019.
- 4. The CEX will establish a new contract in the amount of \$95,000 with the Montgomery Housing Partnership, Inc. (MHP) for the provision of services as stated in the amended FY 2019 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The Council approves an amendment to the Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award and thereby amends Resolution 18-1144, Section G, FY 2019 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award. The Chief Administrative Officer has recommended this action and stated that establishing a contract with this vendor serves a public purpose and is in the public interest.

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The FY 2019 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award Status resolution is amended as follows:

The CEX will establish a new contract in the amount of \$95,000 with the Montgomery Housing Partnership, Inc. to read: "Develop and implement a marketing strategy to promote businesses in Long Branch and on Bonifant Street during Purple Line construction."
