Background

- 1. Section 11B-14 (a) (4) of the Montgomery County Code states that "a contract may be awarded without competition if the Chief Administrative Officer makes a written determination that the contract award serves a public purpose and proposed contractor has been identified in a grant or appropriation resolution approved by the Council." The result of this action is to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award status resolution to include the agency listed below.
- 2. The Chief Administrative Officer has determined that funding for the contract with this entity serves a public purpose and that such an expense would be in the public interest.
- 3. Montgomery County Recreation (MCR) will fund the contract with the entity listed below from existing appropriations for FY20.
- 4. Montgomery County Recreation (MCR) will increase the value of a contract with Interfaith Works, Inc. as stated in the amended FY20 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award.
