**Dear President Riemer:** 

The Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) has completed its review of the **Resolution 18-888 (Amendment)** to the 2003 Montgomery County Comprehensive Water Supply and Sewerage System Plan. The Montgomery County Council approved the Resolution on July 25, 2017. The Resolution establishes a special sewer service area for 16 of 24 properties that were evaluated. Thirteen of these lots are receiving sewer category changes from S-6 to S-3, with service restricted to a single sewer hookup only. Sewer categories for 2 additional lots are being corrected from S-6 to S-1 to recognize the existing WSSC sewer service (see attached table and map).

During MDE's review of the Amendment, the Maryland Department of Planning (MDP) advised the Department that the requests are consistent with the 2002 Potomac Subregion Master Plan (see enclosed comments). In accordance with §9-507(a) of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, the Department hereby approves **Resolution 18-888.**



#### Dear Ms. Outen:

Montgomery County Council approved CR No. 18-888 on July 25, 2017. This Resolution contained 16 category change requests and administrative adjustments, consolidated under a single amendment (WSCCR 17-TRV-07G). This is the first amendment action under CR-18-423, which established the Glen Hills Study Area and its attendant policies on March 8, 2016.

The Maryland Department of Planning (Planning) has reviewed these adopted requests pursuant to our mandate to advise the Maryland Department of the Environment (Environment) on local comprehensive plan consistency and other appropriate matters as required by Environment Article Section 9-507 (b)(2). We offer the following comments for your consideration:

#### Summary of Amendment:

# WSCCR 17-TRV-07G: South Overlea Drive Septic Survey Area

Based on requests from nine property owners, DEP and DPS conducted a survey of 24 properties along Overlea Drive, resulting in a recommendation to designate 16 properties within the survey area as part of a special sewer service area approved for public sewer service. All properties are zoned RE-1, located within the Travilah Planning Area and within the Watts Branch watershed.

County Council Action: Established a special sewer service area that includes 16 of the 24 properties surveyed. Thirteen lots change from S-6 to S-3, restricted to single hookup only. Two lots are corrected from S-6 to S-1 in recognition of existing sewer service.

### **Consistency with the Comprehensive Plan**

# WSCCR 17-TRV-07G: South Overlea Drive Septic Survey Area

Planning finds that this amendment and the establishment of a special sewer service area is **consistent** with the 2002 Potomac Subregion Master Plan. New sewer service for the 16 properties is allowed under the special sewer service area and abutting mains provisions of the new Glen Hills sewer service policy. New sewer hookups cannot be used to support subdivision or resubdivision of existing properties to create new building lots.

Pursuant to the State Finance and Procurement Article, Section 5-7B-02, local jurisdictions are eligible to receive State financial assistance if the project is located in a Priority Funding Area (PFA). All of the properties within WSCCR 17-TRV-07G were determined to be outside the PFA.

The Glen Hills area is designated Tier III on the Montgomery County adopted Tier Map.



### SUBJECT: Amendments to the Comprehensive Water Supply and Sewerage Systems Plan: Establishment of the South Overlea Drive Special Sewer Service Area and Associated Sewer Category Changes

#### Background

- 1. Section 9-501 et seq. of the Environmental Article of the Maryland Code requires the governing body of each County to adopt and submit to the State Department of the Environment a comprehensive County Plan, and from time to time amend or revise that Plan for the provision of adequate water supply systems and sewerage systems throughout the County.
- 2. Section 9-507 of the Environmental Article of the Maryland Code provides that the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) has 90 days to review a county governing body's action to amend the County's Water and Sewer Plan. Upon notice to the County, MDE may extend that review period for another 90 days, if necessary. By the conclusion of this review period, MDE must either approve or reject the Council's action on each of these amendments, or the action is confirmed by default. Any action approved or taken by this resolution is not final until that action is approved by MDE or the period for final MDE action has expired.
- 3. In accordance with the State law on December 30, 1969, by Resolution No. 6-2563, the County Council adopted a Comprehensive Ten-Year Water Supply and Sewerage Systems Plan which was approved by the State Department of the Environment.
- The County Council has from time to time amended the Plan.
- On April 27, 2017, the County Executive transmitted his recommendation to create a special sewer service area along Overlea Drive in the Glen Hills area of Potomac and associated sewer category changes.

- Recommendations on these amendments were solicited from the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission Staff, and affected municipalities.
- 7. A public hearing was held on July 11, 2017.
- 8. The Transportation, Infrastructure, Energy & Environment Committee discussed these amendments on July 20, 2017 and recommended approval as transmitted by the County Executive.
- 9. The Council discussed these amendments on July 25, 2017.





# WSCCR 17-TRV-07G: South Overlea Drive Septic Survey Area

#### Water/Sewer Service Area Categories Information

The Montgomery County Ten-Year Comprehensive Water Supply and Sewerage Systems Plan designates water and sewer service area categories for each property within the county. These service area categories determine a property's eligibility to receive public water and/or sewer service and indicate when the County and the sanitary utility (usually the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC)) should program water and sewerage facilities to serve those properties. (Although the actual provision of public service is often dependent on an applicant's own development schedule.) The Water and Sewer Plan is adopted and amended by the County Council; it is administered by the County Executive through the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP).

### Water and Sewer Service Area Categories Table

Please note that the County does not necessarily assign water and sewer categories in tandem (i.e. W-3 and S-3, or W-5 and S-5), due to differences in water and sewer service policies or to actual water or sewer service availability. Therefore, it is important to know *both* the water *and* sewer service area categories for a property.
