Green Streets are roadway Low Impact Development (LID) designs that reduce and filter rainfall and pollutants that wash off surface areas (stormwater runoff), and enter our streams, degrading the water quality of our local streams and rivers. The Montgomery County Department of Environmental Protection is planning new Green Streets LID practices throughout the Franklin Knolls & Clifton Park neighborhoods for enhanced stormwater management.

The Green Streets LID features provide environmental benefits, improve property aesthetics where reasonably possible, and provide community education opportunities. Installations may include rain gardens, bioretention gardens, bioswales, tree filter boxes, and pavement removals. The project area is split into four phases (see reverse side).



Rain Garden

Through the County's RainScapes Rebate program, Franklin Knolls & Clifton Park residents also have the option to install rain gardens, rain barrels, and other stormwater control features on their property, and have costs partially rebated by the County. See www.rainscapes.org for more details.






