The Montgomery County Department of Environmental Protection, Recycling and Resource Management Division will operate the Montgomery County's Yard Trim Composting Facility, located in Dickerson, Maryland, according to the following Environmental Policy:

COMPLIANCE OBLIGATIONS

Review, document, and report the Facility's compliance status with all voluntary and mandatory compliance obligations.

PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT

- Prevent pollution in all aspects of Facility operations;
- Seek technologies and operational practices to reduce potentially harmful releases to the air, land, or water;
- Pursue strategies to mitigate and reduce any negative impact the Facility, its operations, and products may have on the environment.

CONTINUAL IMPROVEMENT

- The Facilities safety, health, and environmental programs;
- Meeting and exceeding compliance obligations;
- Protecting the environment in all Facility operations and throughout the life cycle of Facility products;
- Formally reviewing our progress, evaluating current processes, procedures, and objectives;
- Managing change effectively.

COMMUNICATION

- Submit quarterly reports on Facility operations;
- Provide notification to the surrounding community and other Facility stakeholders of Facility operations that may impact their community;
- Solicit input from the surrounding community and other Facility stakeholders.
