Presentation on the Recycling Awards Program: Eileen Kao, Recycling and Resources Management Division, Department of Environmental Protection (approx. 5:35)

- Montgomery County's DEP hosts an annual ceremony honoring achievements in waste reduction, reuse and recycling.
- Recognizes individuals, multi-family buildings, businesses, and organizations.
- The awards are presented during the County's Recycling Awareness Week, May 19-23, 2025.

- The award ceremony takes place this year on May 20, 2025. The keynote speaker
 will be the battalion chief of the Montgomery County Fire and Rescue Services who
 will talk about safe disposal of household batteries.
- During the week, the team conducted 13 events over 5 days including 12 school assemblies. The team interacted with 2,294 students.
- All recycling materials are translated into multiple languages.
- There is also a poster contest for students.
- The new recycling volunteer coordinator is Jessica Pannecola who was promoted from within.
- Some SWAC members are interested in hearing from the award winners about their programs.

RRMD Updates (approx. 6:37)

- Another alternative to the Material Recovery and Biological Treatment (MRBT) is being heavily reviewed by DEP.
- SWAC can expect more information on what that alternative would be in the upcoming weeks.

County FY26 Budget (approx. 6:51)

- Work sessions held by the Council revealed that Council staff were skeptical of the budget increases for the Resource Recovery Facility (RRF) and MRBT
 - Increased costs of the RRF (\$35.5 million) for short-term maintenance and repair work raised questions from the Council, which believe it requires further review
- Council is supportive of the Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Fund budgets.
- Council has not had an opportunity to discuss the pros and cons of various longterm disposal alternatives, and more information is expected from DEP detailing the costs and other impacts of the alternatives.
 - SWAC members are surprised that DEP has not briefed the Council with the same presentations and analysis given at SWAC meetings in March and April 2025.
 - SWAC members suggested that SWAC look for opportunities to get more involved with council members (i.e. invite them to SWAC meetings)
