### FY 2022 Income Eligibility Guidelines

Montgomery County homeowners and renters who pay energy costs may be eligible for assistance if they meet the following income guidelines <u>with no household members 67 years of age or older</u> at the time of application:

## 55-Day Hold

- Customers may receive a 55-day hold on their electric & heating accounts if they apply within 14 days of the issuance of a termination notice. Completed application with a termination notice needed to qualify for a hold.
- Customers may only receive one 55-day hold per program year
- Customers may not receive a 55-day hold on approved application
- The 55-day hold may be terminated if the customer is determined ineligible for OHEP or does not complete the application requirements
