PURPOSE

This letter is to inform you of the upcoming Grosvenor Lane to I-495 sidewalk and curb/gutter repair project. This concrete preservation project employs long term strategies to improve sidewalk and curb/gutter conditions.





SCHEDULE

This project is scheduled to start in July and will take 6-8 weeks to complete. weather and other operational requirements permitting. Work hours will be between 7am and 7pm, Monday through Friday.


