**NOTICE OF DRAINAGE PROJECT IN YOUR AREA
WEST WILLARD ROAD**

Dear Resident:

This letter is to inform you of an emergency storm drain pipe replacement project in your area. The project is being managed by the Montgomery County Department of Transportation (MCDOT). Due to a pavement depression in the roadway, MCDOT staff conducted an inspection and found the existing corrugated metal pipes have deteriorated and are in need of replacement.

The two failed pipes will be replaced with new concrete pipes, which will provide greater strength and durability. The repairs require the closure of a small section of West Willard Road. Weather permitting, the project is expected to take **three (3) weeks** to complete. Road closure and detour signs, as well as other construction related activities, can be expected in the area. Please follow the posted detours.

The pipe replacement project and road closure is scheduled to begin in mid to late September 2016. MCDOT will make every effort to expedite the work to facilitate an accelerated completion with the least amount of inconvenience to nearby residents.
