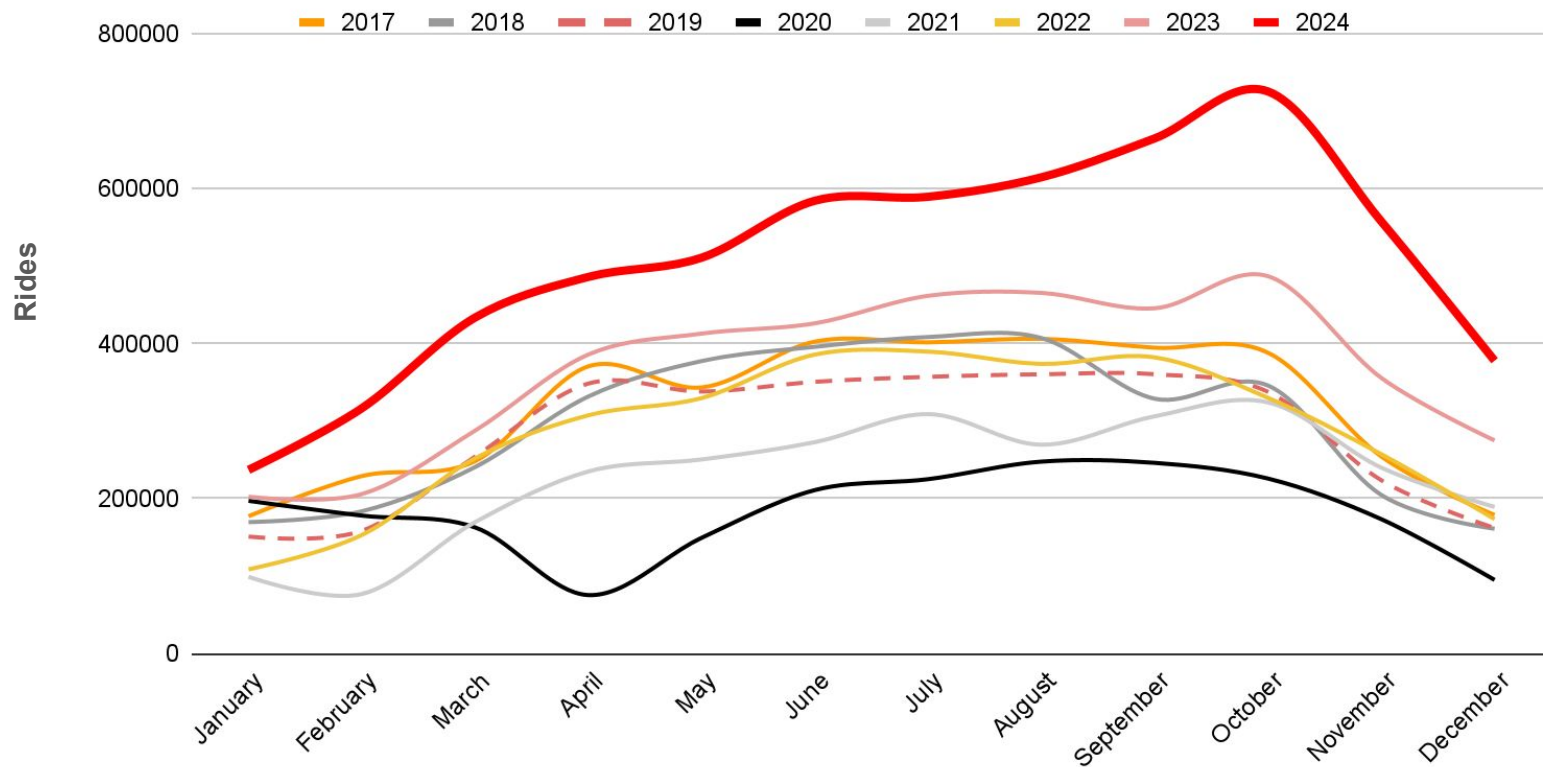

Capital Bikeshare Equipment



- Launched 9/2010
- Non-Ebike
- Must be docked in station
- Free for 45 min for members
- 5000 in system as of 10/24



- Launched 3/2023
- Next Gen Ebike
- Can be docked in station or parked dockless
- Pay per minute and to park out of station
- 3000 in system



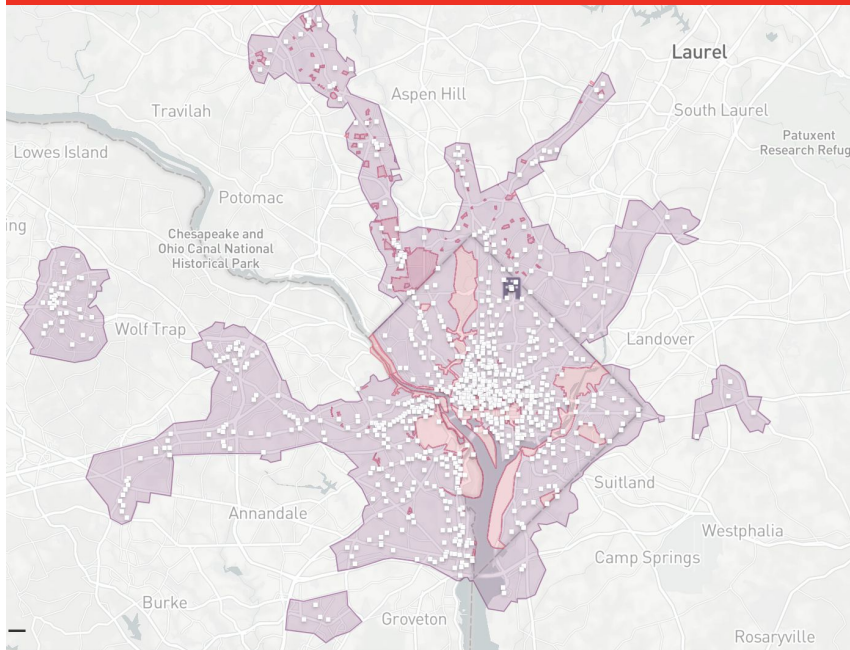
- Launched 9/2024
- Next Gen Station
- Can have charging capability for ebikes
- 6 currently in network



- Launched 9/2024
- 4 solar canopy deployed funded through DOEE pilot
- Charges next-gen bikes in pillar stations

Station footprint as of 10/2024

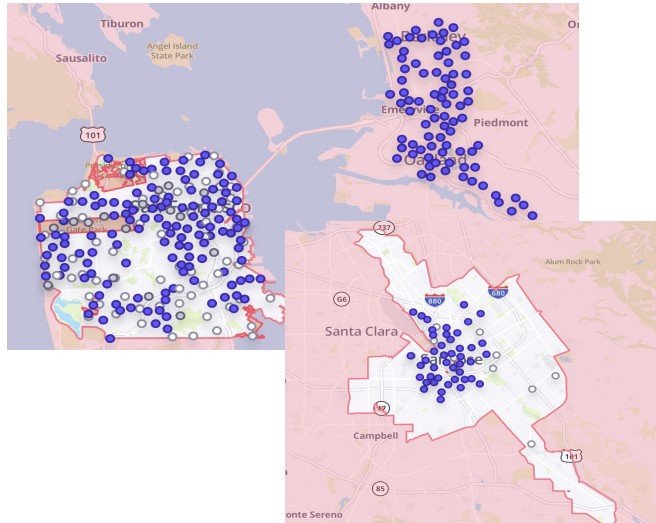

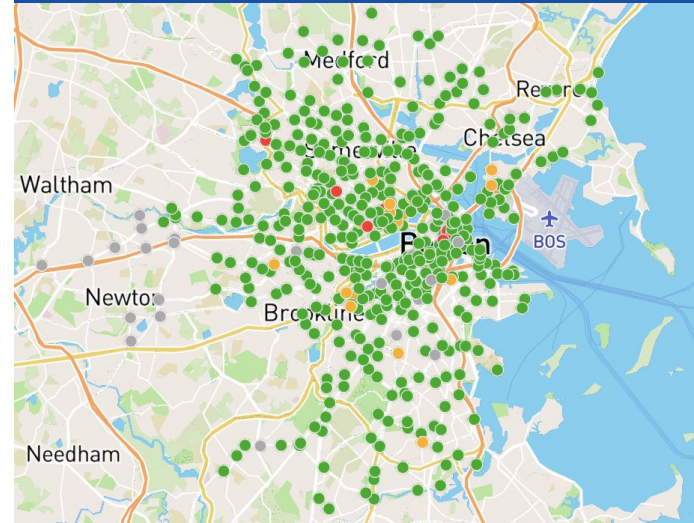
Other Regional Bikeshare Programs: Service Area

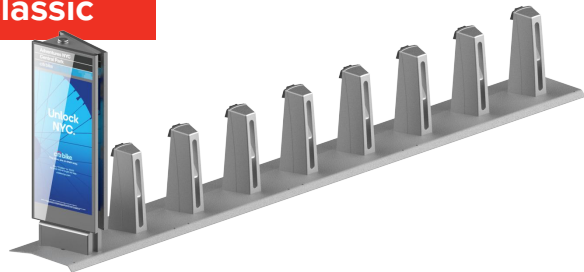

Solar Charging

There are 2 station types in the CaBi network

Classic



- Launched 9/2010
- Older gen station
- Has a kiosk where customers can purchase trips with a credit card
- Relies on kiosk as the “brain”
- No longer available for purchase
- 775 currently in network

Pillar



- Launched 9/2024
- Next Gen Station
- Each dock can exist on it's own, so modular (but smallest config recommended is 4 docks)
- Kiosk option coming in 2026
- Can have charging capability for ebikes
- 6 currently in network
