Montgomery County Department of Transportation, Transit Services would like to propose changes to Routes 43 (new Sunday service), 76 (new Saturday service) and 90 (new midday service). These changes would improve the span of service on the weekday and offer additional services for Route 90 during the middle of the day.

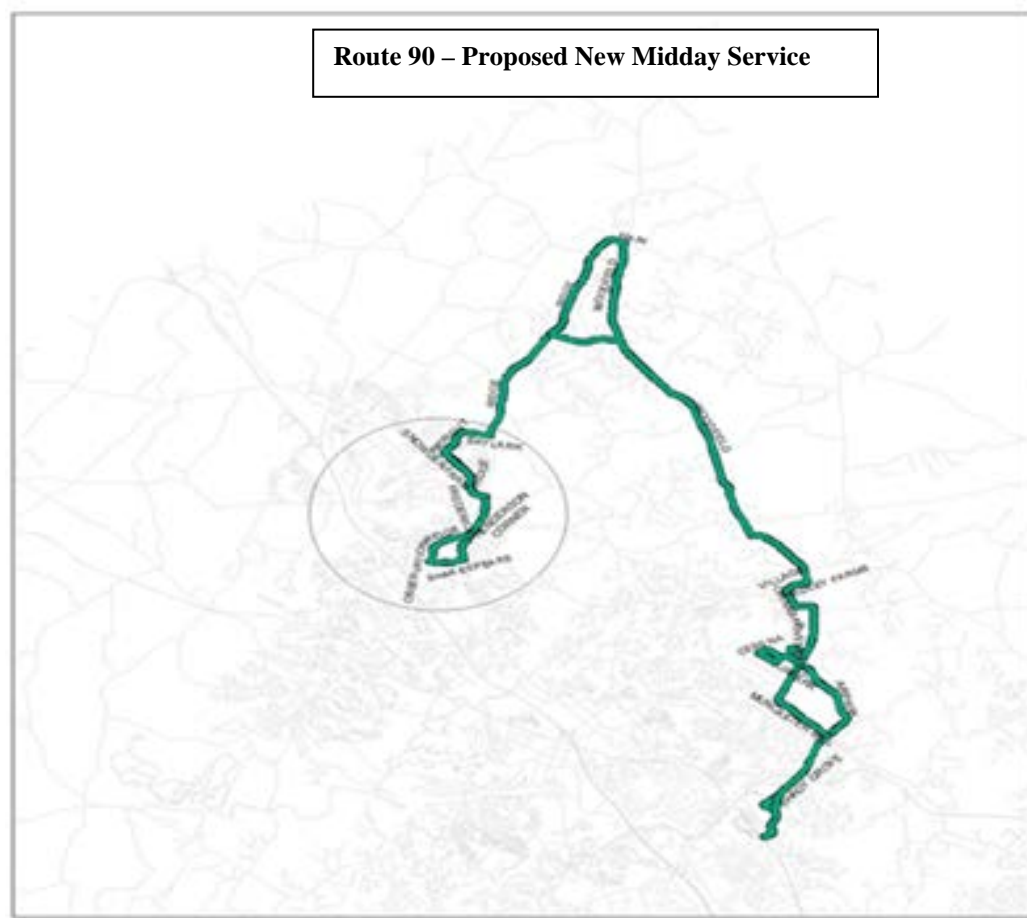
Montgomery County hereby notifies the general public and other interested parties that a public forum will be held on **Wednesday, August 8, 2018** starting at 6:30 p.m. and ending after the last speaker at the UpCounty Regional Services Center, located at 12900 Middlebrook Road, Suite 1000, Germantown, MD 20874. In the case of inclement weather, the public forum will be held on August 9, 2018.

Individuals and representatives of organizations who would like to speak at the public forum are requested to furnish in writing, on or before **August 5, 2018**, their name, home address, telephone number, e-mail address and organization to Division of Transit Services, Ride On Public Forum, 101 Monroe Street, 5th Floor, Rockville, Maryland 20850. Individuals who have signed up to speak must bring two (2) printed copies of their testimony for the record. Sign language interpreter services will be provided only upon request with notice as far in advance as possible but not less than 3 business days prior to the date of the forum. Large print format is available upon request. All comments will be considered before any changes are finalized.
