



Ride On Montgomery County Transit Notice of Public Forum On Proposed New Service Expansions Effective: January 2018

The public will have a chance to comment on a new limited stop service along US29 (Columbia Pike) called Route 129. This service will operate from Silver Spring Transit Center to Burtonsville Park and Ride Lot with 14 limited stops along the route. Route 129 is an overlay of the existing local service along US29 and provide a faster option for riders during rush hours. Buses will operate every 15 minutes from 5:30 am to 9:00 am and 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm.

Come find out about the details of the route. Fares will be the same as the local service and loading cash to SmarTrip cards onboard will be allowed.

Those wishing to speak must provide such information by three (3) days before the forum. Those who have signed up to speak must bring two printed copies of their testimony for the record.

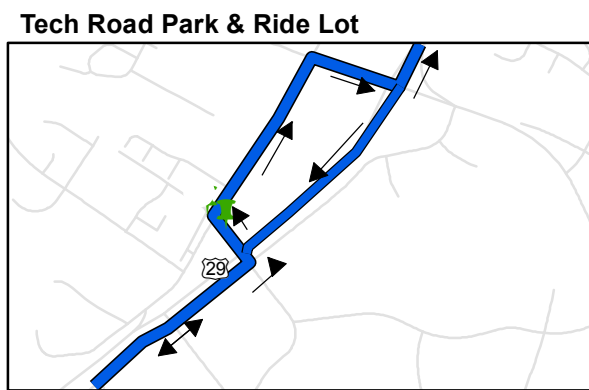
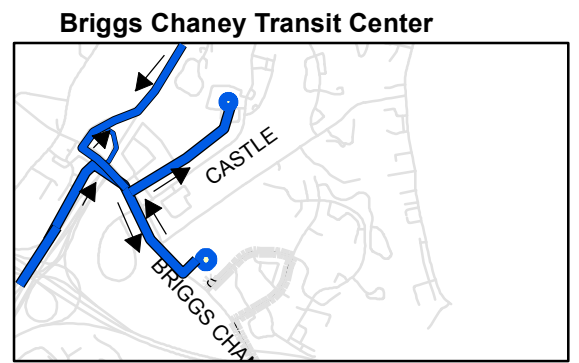
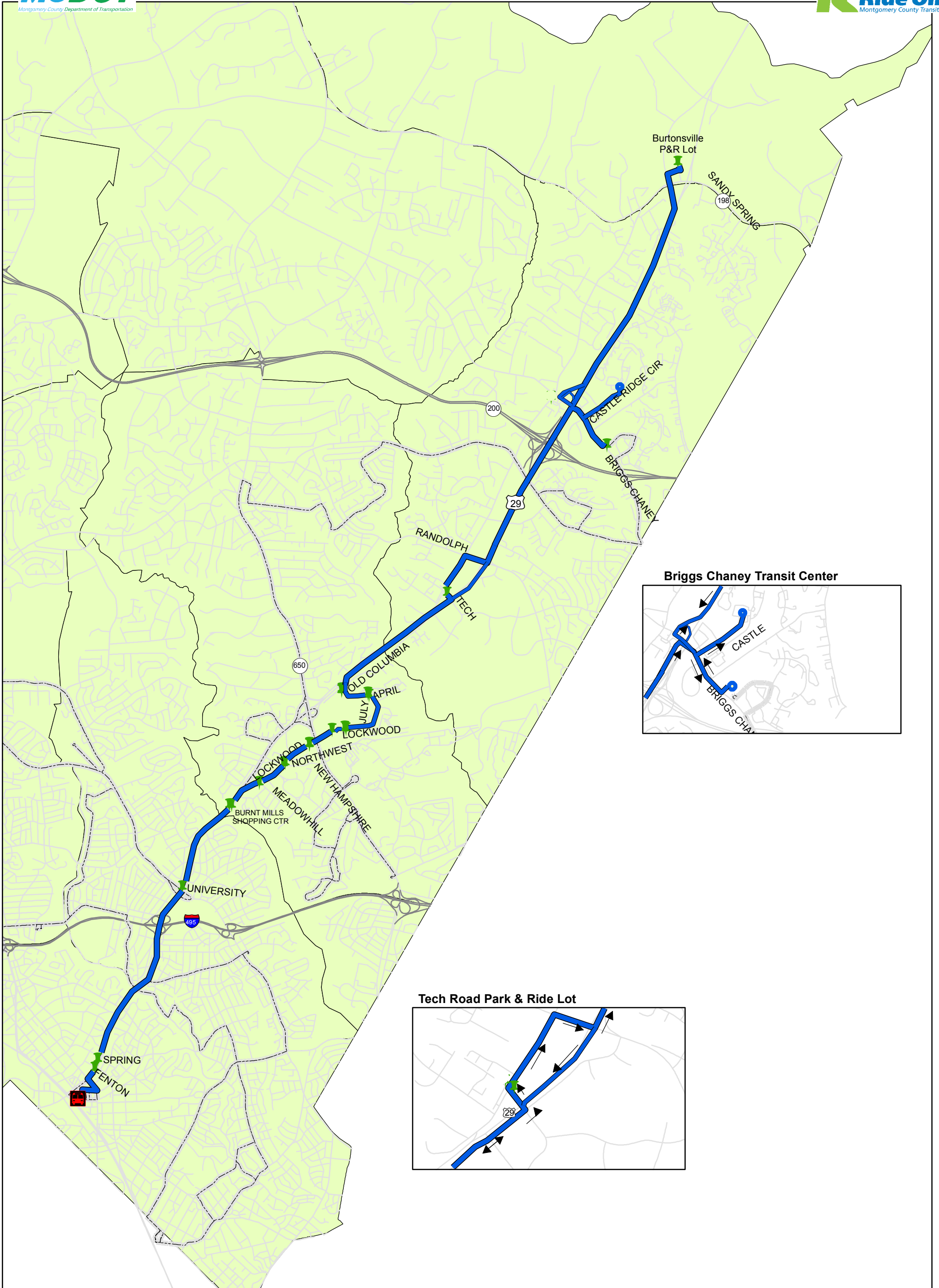
