



Commercial Retaining Walls Checklist

For Commercial Retaining Walls

Building Permit Application
Sediment control Permit Number written at the top of the application (if applicable).
Two (2) sets of constructions drawings to include, code analysis and scope of work.
Original seal and signature of Maryland registered Architect or Engineer, including <u>titleblock</u> <u>requirements</u> , on each page.
Four (4) complete site plans, additional site plan if on well and/or septic or if <u>Right-of-Way permit</u> required.
Completed, signed revocable letter if the structure extends into or over right of way.
Fees - Check made payable to 'Montgomery County, MD':
 <u>Building permit filing fee</u>: Site address is located in the Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission plan review area-\$825
Site address is located in the Department of Permitting Services plan review area- <mark>\$515</mark>
 Add an additional 10% <u>automation enhancement fee</u> to all fees shown above.
Miscellaneous Information:

- If the address is within certain <u>municipalities</u>, such as Poolesville, Barnesville, Brookeville, Chevy Chase, Laytonsville or Washington Grove, a copy of the building permit or approval from them is required with application.
- If there has been a Special Exception granted for this lot from the <u>Board of Appeals</u>, supply a copy.
