Montgomery County Board of Elections December 2024



THANK YOU to everyone who served in the 2024 Primary and General Presidential Elections. We appreciate your commitment to ensuring a fair and accessible elections and to the integrity of the electoral process. Your participation enabled 523,824 voters in Montgomery County to cast their ballots either in-person during early voting or on election day, or by mail-in in the 2024 Presidential General Election.

What's Next

Processing of the election service stipends is completed, and checks have been mailed to the address of record. The service stipend checks do not include a breakdown of service, just the total for all election service (Election Judge, Canvasser, Drop Box Attendant, or Nursing Home Program Volunteer). Returning Election Judges who previously served (in 2022 or earlier) at a polling place during Early Voting and/or Election Day are eligible to earn a \$100 bonus for each full day served and \$50 bonus for each part day served at a polling place during Early Voting and/or Election Day in the 2024 election cycle.

Note: If your first time serving as an Election Judge was the 2024 Presidential Primary Election, you will be eligible to receive the returning bonus in 2026 Elections.

Election Judge Service Pins

The Board of Elections provides a token of appreciation to volunteers who served in the 2024 Elections with a commemorative lapel pin. The Election Worker Recruitment Team mailed Election Service Pins to those who did not receive a pin this Election Cycle.
