### **VOTER REGISTRATION AND PARTY AFFILIATION CHANGE DEADLINE NEARS**

Is your voter registration up to date? Is your residential address current? Is your political party affiliation, correct? Do you wish to change your political party affiliation or make any other changes to your voter registration? Montgomery County citizens who wish to vote in the 2022 Gubernatorial Primary Election need to complete and submit their voter registration application no later than Tuesday, June 28, 2022, by 9:00 p.m.

Maryland holds closed party primaries. Only registered voters affiliated with the Democratic or Republican parties receive a ballot for that party. Unaffiliated voters will vote only for candidates for the Board of Education.

Registering to vote requires that you are a US citizen, live in Montgomery County, Maryland, and are or will be at least 18 years of age on or before November 8, 2022. Registered voters can review/update their voter record by texting CHECK to 77788, or <https://voterservices.elections.maryland.gov/VoterSearch> or call 240-777-8500 to verify their voter registration using the automated phone system or for assistance.

Individuals who are not registered but have a valid Maryland Driver's license, Permit or MVA ID can register by texting VOTE to 77788 or at <https://voterservices.elections.maryland.gov/OnlineVoterRegistration/InstructionsStep1>.
