- Voting Operations Judge – A shift (hours – 6:00 am to 3:00 pm) **Part-time morning**
- Voting Operations Judge – B shift (hours – 2:00 pm to about 10:00 pm) **Part-time evening**
- Voting Operations Judge – Driver (hours – 6:00am to about 9:00 pm, requires a cell phone and vehicle) **All day position**
- Opener (hours – 6:00 am to 1:00 pm) **Part-time morning**
- Closing Judge (hours – 6:30 pm to about 11:00 pm, requires a cell phone and vehicle) **Part-time evening**
- Runner (hours – 5:30 am to 11:30 am OR 11:00 am to 5:00 pm, requires the ability to drive throughout county, a cell phone, and vehicle) **Part-time shift**
- Chief Judge (hours – 6:00 am to about 10:00 pm, requires prior experience as a judge, a cell phone, and vehicle) **All day position**
- Roamer (hours – 5:00 am to about 11:00 pm, requires prior experience, excellent organization and computer skills, a cell phone, and vehicle) **All day position**
- Early Voting-** Judges must complete training for Election Day to be eligible to serve during Early Voting.

**PART D: PLEDGE** - *To ensure fair and honest election results, I certify that:*

1) I agree not to (a) hold or be a candidate for any elective public or political party office or any other office created under the Constitution or Laws of the State; (b) use my official authority as an Election Judge for the purpose of influencing or affecting the results of an election; or (c) not to serve as a campaign manager for a candidate or as the treasurer for a campaign finance entity. 2) As an Election Judge I will arrive to the Monday night meeting and my Election Day post at the assigned time. I will not leave the polling place, for any reason, at anytime during Election Day or Early Voting days while the polls are open. 3) I agree to be courteous, respectful and to assist all voters regardless of national origin, race, creed, gender, age, physical challenge or proficiency in the English language. 4) I am prepared to fulfill my responsibility to conduct the election according to federal, state and local election laws and policies 5) I agree not to take out or use my personal cell phone at anytime while the polls are open unless I am a Roamer, Technician or Chief Judge in which case, I am permitted to use my personal cell phone only to communicate with the Board of Elections. I agree not to bring or use any electronic devices at anytime in the polls. 6) I understand that I cannot bring children and/or pets to training or to the polls on Election Day. 7) I understand that if I am under 18 years of age, I must have a parent/guardian’s permission to participate.
