We will distribute the packages at the Summit on Aging and we will upload the files to the CoA website. ACTION ITEM: Tina

Presentation:

- Mona Negm, American Muslim Senior Society discussed that the AMSS works through and with partners like Montgomery County HHS. They work with communities of color with health disparities. Recently they held a series of community discussions to find out about immediate and long term concerns about Mental Health. AMSS had their first summit in 2021 and then in December of 2022, held their Mental Health Summit
 (https://www.amssmd.org/files/ugd/6d4bcd/5be8cb44b10240b49e3a0f075000fca7.pdf). In
 September 2023, they held a Call to Action roundtable discussion to develop and rank priorities
 for an Action Plan and Implementation Strategies for moving forward.
- AMSS is a program that is run under the American Asian Health Initiative (AAHI). There was a discussion about the summary of the September Summit. At the Summit Dr. Santiago presented materials developed to inform the public about knowing when to call 988, 311, 4000#
 ACTION ITEM: follow <u>up--Melodie.Monroe@montgomerycountymd.gov</u> about available information resources for the public.

Due to an emergency, Mona was unable to complete her report on recommendations from the September AMSS roundtable. **ACTION ITEM:** Tina and Mona will work to inform the committee about these recommendations as soon as possible.
