Dental benefits include a full range of services for eligible patients, such as regularly scheduled cleaning and x-rays, restorative procedures such as fillings, crowns and bridges, dentures, oral surgery such as tooth extractions, and access to oral and facial reconstruction surgery resulting from trauma or serious illness. Contact nearest VA to find out if you qualify for dental benefits. If you are not eligible for VA Dental Care, the VA is implementing a comprehensive national VA Dental Insurance Program (VADIP) to give enrolled Veterans and CHAMPVA beneficiaries the opportunity to purchase dental insurance through Delta Dental and MetLife at a reduced cost. Participation is voluntary and purchasing a dental plan does not affect Veterans current eligibility for VA dental services and treatment.
