Helps low to moderate income HIV-positive Maryland residents access drugs to treat HIV infection, opportunistic infections, and complications of HIV infection or related conditions. MADAP pays for medications for eligible clients with no insurance and helps clients with insurance by paying for eligible co-pay and deductible costs so they can get their medication. The list of medicines covered by MADAP includes a wide range of medications used to treat HIV infection, opportunistic infections, and complications of HIV infection or related conditions, including all anti-retroviral therapies approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. Funded primarily through the Ryan White CARE Act.

**Testing Program:** Services include diagnostic testing, exams and treatment of STD's and epidemiological follow up. Free, anonymous and confidential HIV testing is also offered. All persons tested for HIV receive pre- and post-test counseling. Offer accessible exam tables.

**Clinical Services:** The Patient Services Diagnostic Unit provides additional lab test and diagnostic evaluations of persons tested positive for HIV. Patients diagnosed with STD are also treated. **HIV Case**

**Management:** Provide HIV Seropositive Services including case management, diagnostic evaluation unit, HIV outpatient clinic services, HIV dental care and nutritional and addictions counseling. On-going support groups are available for anyone who is HIV positive or has AIDS. Home health care services are offered as needed. Education and outreach to at risk populations are also provided.
